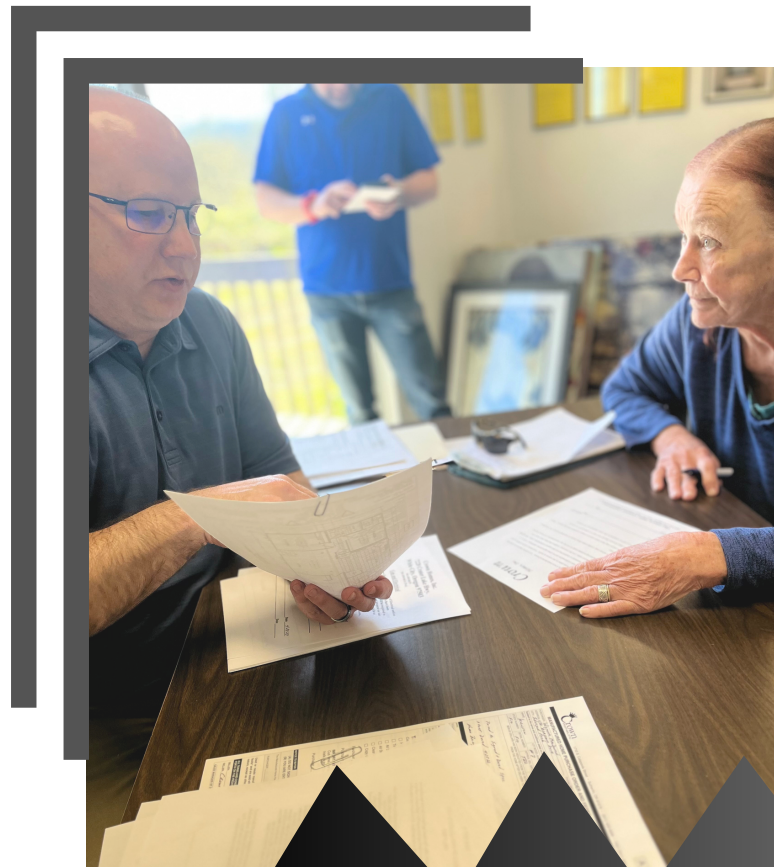

Contracts signed on two new homes!

Since the devastating Archie Creek Fire on September 8th, 2020, numerous families have been living in travel trailers, desperately seeking a permanent solution. However, on April 25th, 2023, hope and joy filled the air as two separate families proudly signed their new home contracts! Thanks to the combined efforts of Oregon Housing Community Services, UCAN, and Glide Revitalization these families now have brand new manufactured homes waiting for them with delivery scheduled in the next 30 days. Each home will be carefully placed on their pre-fire properties, complete with foundation preparations and utility hook-ups. It's a fresh start they truly deserve!

The selection process for these homes was meticulous, taking into account the level of destruction caused by the fire, the families' income, insurance coverage, and other benefits received. This ensured that the homes were allocated to those who needed them most urgently. We couldn't be more grateful to witness such a heartwarming example of community support and resilience. Let's celebrate the new chapter in the lives of these families as they transition from RV living to the comfort and stability of their new homes.

Glide Revitalization is in a unique position. We operate as a non-profit that can obtain grant funding for a wide variety of programs and community based assistance. We also house Douglas County's Long-Term Recovery Group (LTRG). This is a committee of individuals that are governed by a Board of Directors and are fiscally sponsored by a 501(c)(3) organization. All funding that is allocated to this local group of individuals is provided specifically to wildfire impacted community members.

We also partner with many other non-profit organizations to maximize efforts. Often, cases are presented to many community business partners to ensure the client receives the most amount of assistance available to them.

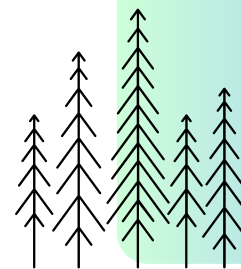
