a Cub favorite that supports people of all ages weighing 40 to 250 lbs. You can set it up in a parking lot or field to create a highly visible, exciting activity with a loud horn that draws attention from a distance. Training: Your leaders can become trained tower operators by completing <u>online training</u> and hands-on assessments. Contact <u>NCAC.COPE@gmail.com</u> to schedule an assessment.

Reservations: Contact <u>Stephanie Messenger</u> at <u>Camp</u> <u>William B. Snyder</u> to reserve the Scouterhorn. Rental fee \$165 when used at CWBS, \$275 off site.

Permits: In <u>Maryland</u> you must file a permit <u>request</u> at least 30 days before your event. In <u>Virginia</u> permits are issued by local building departments. Find contact information for a department official near your event location on this <u>list</u> or with this <u>interactive map</u>. In DC call <u>DCRA Permits</u> at 202-442-4589.

Transportation: Requires 4800 lb. towing capacity. Contact your <u>District Executive</u> to arrange towing with a council truck. If you supply the truck, be sure to have a 2 5/16" ball bumper pull hitch and 7-Prong Electrical Plug
