- Mansfield Kaseman Health Clinic - Health care supplies and equipment for low income residents in the Rockville and surrounding area
- Nourish Now - Providing funding for food for 2,000 City of Rockville Residents
- Sponsoring Cub Scout Pack 492, Scouts BSA Troop 492B and Scouts BSA Troop 492G
- Ending polio — Partnering with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the World Health Organization, and UNICEF to end polio, once and for all
- In 2023, the Rockville Rotary Club Foundation is awarding grants of \$40,000 to 18 organizations and club projects
