



THE GREATER SCALES


Commonly understood to be a term encompassing the entirety of all transactions between this earthly realm and the other - are the physical manifestation of the eternal fluctuations of universal expansion.

Commonly understood to be a term encompassing all singular transactions between practicing members of various schools, is the physical arena in which practitioners engage in both hostile and mortal takeovers.


