### **Three Major Tasks:**

- Develop a new Comprehensive Plan to guide land use and development decisions throughout unincorporated Cherokee County in compliance with state law
- Draft Zoning Regulations and prepare updates to the Land Development Regulations
- Prepare Zoning Implementation Plan

- Guide for land use, redevelopment, and growth
- Guide for capital investments and community initiatives
- Compliance with the State's Planning Enabling Act






