General Updates

- IPEDS The Academic Library portion of the IPEDS survey is due in early April.
 Please follow your individual Institutional Research office deadlines for submission.

- NOVELny The State Library is convening a committee to determine the most effective way to allocate additional NOVELny funding. Maureen Clements has been asked to serve on the committee as the SUNY representative.



NOVELny

- All SUNY campus libraries use GALE resources.
 Forty-seven SUNY campus libraries use Britannica Academic.
- SUNY students, faculty, and staff accessed nearly 2 million items (1.9 M downloads) from NOVELny resources during the 2022-2023 academic year.
- In AY 2022-2023, SUNY comprised more than half (56%) of the statewide NOVELny usage of Gale databases for all college and university academic libraries (including SUNY, CUNY, and private colleges and universities.) During the same period, SUNY's usage of Britannica totaled 30% of statewide NOVELny usage for college and university academic libraries.
