This is Kinda Like a Primary Care Behavioral Health Clinician Facilitating Care with a Traditional Mental Health Therapist Colleague

Specialty Mental Health & Substance Use Care	Primary Care Behavioral Health Care
Generally 45-60 minutes Sometimes shorter - sometimes longer	Generally 15-30 minutes Sometimes shorter - sometimes longer
Often 60-min visit blocks Often no same-day scheduling	Often 30-min visit blocks 50% of schedule is for same-day scheduling
Visits can be non-directive or directive	Visits are generally directive, focused & action-oriented
Open & close to care	Open door to care No close
Care by a clinician from a profession working independently	Care by an interprofessional team working interdependently
Specialist Comprehensive support within a profession	Generalist Comprehensive whole person support by a team
Most focused on psychological & sociocultural health	Focused on physical health in addition to psychological and sociocultural health
Care is episodic Frequent visits for a few months to a couple years	Care is episodic Frequent visits at times for a month or two Infrequent over years Access to care today for life
