PRAYER FOR SINS OF THE FATHERS AND RESULTING CURSES

Father God, I come before you in the name of Jesus Christ my Savior and Lord. I confess that my ancestors and I have sinned and done evil in your sight.

Thank you Father, for sending your only son Jesus, to die in my place; to pay the penalty for my sins through His shed blood and to bear the punishment for the sins and iniquities of my ancestors in His bruised and broken body on the cross. Thank you that He is my Holy Scapegoat. Thank you too, Father, that He was wounded that I may be healed.

I choose now to confess and take accountability for the sins of my father's and mother's line back to the fourth generation and to the tenth generation for sexual sins.

1. I confess all ***involvement and tampering with the occult and the hidden things of darkness*** in my father's and mother's line. I recognize that supernatural knowledge and power not coming from God is sinful.
2. I confess ***all sin, especially sins of dishonor, oppression, injustice and sexual sin*** in my father's and mother's line.
3. I confess ***the sin of anti-semitism*** in my father's and mother's line.
4. I confess all ***religious restrictions, constrictions and trying to live by the law*** in my father's and mother's line, either from a Christian denomination or church, from a different religion or from cultic involvement.
5. I confess ***the sin of robbing God by withholding tithes and offerings*** in my father's and mother's line.
6. I confess the ***sin of cursing myself or others through spoken word*** in my father's and mother's line.
7. I confess all ***mental illness*** in my father's and mother's line: anxiety, depression, phobias and obsessions, schizophrenia and manic depression...
8. I confess all ***ungodly thoughts and negative emotions*** that have had an ill effect on my father's and mother's line and on my marriage: pride, anger, arrogance, violence, fear, bitterness, resentment, and shame, ungodly domination and control, racism, hatred of women and despising of men...
9. I confess all ***hereditary illnesses and sicknesses*** in my father's and mother's line...
10. I confess all ***barrenness, miscarriages or related female problems*** in my father's and mother's line.
