Right now, we're entering just our book orders.

We're entering print orders, but not electronic orders.

Making the most of Alma acquisitions

In order to use ALL ("full") acquisitions features and functions in Alma, you'll need:

1 - at least one fund structure (ledger, summary fund, child fund, allocated fund), and;

2 - one vendor record.









The Good News

In order to use ALL ("full") acquisitions features and functions in Alma, you'll need:

1 - at least one fund structure (ledger, summary fund, child fund, allocated fund) -----> we can help with that!

2 - one vendor record -----> needed for "technical," anyway

Designed to make your life easier

- Order templates same vendor, same fund, etc.
- Ordering print and electronic versions of the same title.
- Orders without inventory track "other" internal expenses.
- Order and invoice at the same time.
- Receive and barcode/process at the same time.











Designed to make your life easier - cont'd

- "Renew" subscriptions automatically.
- Create expected issues for periodicals.
- Reporting codes instead of complicated fund structure
- Shortcuts for gifts, donations, etc.
- Order APIs from vendors GOBI/OASIS











Collection Development meets Resource Management meets Acquisitions

Orders are initiated from repository records.

In general—
Print records from the NZ
Electronic records from the CZ

Consider (ponder, brainstorm) ways that your current "offline" purchase/selection system can be adapted to Alma acquisitions workflows.
