POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position will have the following responsibilities:

- Assist with set-up and maintenance of a safe waterfront area during summer camp season.
- Communicate and enforce established waterfront regulations.
- Conduct weekly swim tests for all campers.
- Supervise health and safety at the waterfront.
- Be on duty as a lifeguard during waterfront activities, when assigned.
- · Facilitate and lead a Trust Group for the week, when assigned.
- Develop, implement and lead evening field game activities.
- · Assist in the kitchen and dining hall for one meal per day.
- Attend all meals.
- Assist with enforcing and implementing camp safety standards and emergency procedures.
- Assist with the cleaning of the cabins and common areas during weeklyy site cleaning.
- Complete other tasks related to the implementation of a quality youth summer camp program, as assigned.
