






Steps for Intercollegiate Team Compliance

 Log onto Members Only via <u>www.usfsaonline.org</u> then go to Menu (top left) > Teams > My Teams.



2. Look at "End Date" and "Team Requirements'. End date should say **6/30/2025** and team requirements should say "Complete".









3. Click "Main Roster: Manage" to enter your team's profile. You will be prompted to renew the team with 2 steps: updating Team Profile and updating the Main Roster.

Team Renewal Step 1: Verify your Team's Profile. Click save after you have completed the profile. You may appoint Team Coaches / Managers now or after you have renewed. Cancel Renewal


4. Once you verify and hit 'save', you will be automatically redirected to your 2024-2025 Main Roster. This roster should include all athletes on the team, whether they are competing or not.









Add Team Member

Select "Add Team Member" and click the "Search" button. It is preferable to search based on member number rather than first/last name.



Once you have finished removing/adding skaters, press 'Finalize Team Renewal'.

5. You will now be prompted to pay your team's dues (new for the 24-25 season). Submit









payment via a credit card, and proceed to check out.



6. Navigate back to your team profile (Teams > My Teams). Now take a look at the "Skater Requirements" column. Skater Requirements are the waivers and forms that each skater is required to fill out in order to compete or participate on the team. These should ALL say "Complete". If listed as "Not Complete", you can click to see what components the skater is missing. When all skaters on your roster have completed their skater requirements, the "Team Requirements" will be completed.





Skaters can access their forms by going to Account > Member Profile > 2024-2025 Competition Season Profile. Skaters need to complete all waivers, the medical registry, and the media/school information form.






7. If a Minor Athlete (17 years old and under) is on your team, you are required to list them on your roster and ALL SKATERS are required to complete and have a current SafeSport™ training. If a Minor Athlete will turn 18 in the middle of the season, all Adult Participants (18 years and older) on the team are required to complete their Mandatory Athlete compliance requirements. You should be able to track their compliance and training in the "Compliant" column (see below).



8. All Team Managers are required to have current U.S. Figure Skating membership, complete an annual SafeSport™ training course, and have a current NCSI green-light background check. Team Coaches are required to complete all mandatory Coach compliance items, as determined by U.S. Figure Skating. You can track your Team Managers' and team Coaches' compliance in the Team Compliance tab.










The Compliant column will display a future end if the Participants compliance will expire midseason- this date signifies when the Participants SafeSport™ Training will expire. If someone's SafeSport™ training expires mid-season, they are required to complete the next applicable course in their sequence in order to be compliant for the remainder of the season. The SafeSport courses that meet the Center's mandatory training requirements are, in sequence, SafeSport Trained, Refresher 1, Refresher 2, and Refresher 3.

If a Participant is listed as "No" under the Compliant column, you can click the "No" icon to see what items they are missing.
