### "If I Were The Devil": A Warning to America From Paul Harvey, 1965

"If I were the devil ... If I were the Prince of Darkness, I'd want to engulf the whole world in darkness. And I'd have a third of its real estate, and four-fifths of its population, but I wouldn't be happy until I had seized the ripest apple on the tree — Thee.

So I'd set about however necessary to take over the United States. I'd subvert the churches first — I'd begin with a campaign of whispers. With the wisdom of a serpent, I would whisper to you as I whispered to Eve: 'Do as you please.

To the young, I would whisper that 'The Bible is a myth.' I would convince them that man created God instead of the other way around. I would confide that what's bad is good, and what's good is 'square.' And the old, I would teach to pray, after me, 'Our Father, which art in Washington...

And then I'd get organized. I'd educate authors in how to make lurid literature exciting, so that anything else would appear dull and uninteresting. I'd threaten TV with dirtier movies and vice versa. I'd pedal narcotics to whom I could. I'd sell alcohol to ladies and gentlemen of distinction. I'd tranquilize the rest with pills.

If I were the devil I'd soon have families at war with themselves, churches at war with themselves, and nations at war with themselves; until each in its turn was consumed. And with promises of higher ratings I'd have mesmerizing media fanning the flames. If I were the devil I would encourage schools to refine young intellects, but neglect to discipline emotions — just let those run wild, until before you knew it, you'd have to have drug sniffing dogs and metal detectors at every schoolhouse door.

Within a decade I'd have prisons overflowing, I'd have judges promoting pornography — soon I could evict God from the courthouse, then from the schoolhouse, and then from the houses of Congress. And in His own churches I would substitute psychology for religion, and deify science. I would lure priests and pastors into misusing boys and girls, and church money. If I were the devil I'd make the symbols of Easter an egg and the symbol of Christmas a bottle.

If I were the devil I'd take from those who have, and give to those who want until I had killed the incentive of the ambitious.

And what do you bet I could get whole states to promote gambling as the way to get rich? I would caution against extremes and hard work in Patriotism, in moral conduct. I would convince the young that marriage is old-fashioned, that swinging is more fun, that what you see on the TV is the way to be. And thus, I could undress you in public, and I could lure you into bed with diseases for which there is no cure. In other words, if I were the devil I'd just keep right on doing what he's doing."

#### **MAIN QUESTIONS:**

How do we vote?

How do we INFLUENCE our nation for GOOD?

Matthew record the sermon on the Mount in chapters 5-8. Jesus is preaching his own catechesis...a lofty and idealist perspective of where and how to set our aim. Jesus knew what we were created for...and he was reminding us that we have gotten far too comfortable with all of the ways we have compromised...

Mt. 5:13-16: 13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by people.

14 "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; 15 nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 Your light must shine before people in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

- 1.We are the salt of the Earth & the light of the world.
  - A. Salt is a preservation agent.
  - B. Light helps people see.
  - C. When we lose our influence...we've lost our purpose.
    - Historically...the church has changed the world:

      - How?→Individual transformation, the sanctity of human life, an elevated sexual morality, women
        receiving freedom & dignity, charity & compassion, hospitals & health care, imprint on education, labor
        & economic freedom dignified, the christian roots of science, liberty and justice for all, slavery
        abolished, stamp on art & architecture, music, literature, holidays, words, symbols, & expressions.
      - Christianity has CHANGED the world we live in FOR THE BETTER.
    - Stark, Rodney, America's Blessing: How Religion Benefits Everyone, Including Atheists.
      - Religious Americans much less likely to commit crimes, to give of their finances and volunteer, enjoy superior mental health (far less likely to commit suicide), live longer (7 years), husbands far less likely to abuse their wives, enjoy their sex lives more, students perform better on standardized tests, less likely to drop out of school (esp. true of Hispanic and African American), get better jobs and less likely to be on welfare, more likely to enjoy "high culture," & less likely to believe in Bigfoot, UFO's, Atlantis, ghosts, haunted houses, & astrology. . .
      - I'm from Washington State. . . & im pretty sure Bigfoot exists.

Mt. 5:17-20: 17 "Do not presume that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish, but to fulfill.

18 For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke of a letter shall pass from the Law, until all is accomplished! 19 Therefore, whoever nullifies one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever keeps and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

20 "For I say to you that unless your righteousness far surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.

- 2. God's Law is GOOD & has eternal significance.
  - A. 3 types of Law: Moral, Ceremonial, & Civil
    - Moral: Universal applicable for eternity The 10 Commandments for example.
    - Ceremonial: Rituals, Feasts, religious regulations. Jesus fulfilled the this Law.
    - Civil: Israel as a nation: Justice, Order, "love your neighbor as yourself. . ." Principles still applicable.
  - B. God will judges individuals & nations for breaking God's Law.
    - Moral Decay in Sodom & Gomorrah: Gen. 19
    - Pride & Arrogance in Edom: Obadiah 1:3-4
    - Violence & Bloodshed Ninevah: Nahum 3:1
    - Child Sacrifice in Canaan & Eventually Israel: Psalm 106:37-38
    - Sexual Immorality & Pride in Moab: Jeremiah 48:42-44 & Isaiah 16:6
    - Greed & Commercial Exploitation in Tyre: Isaiah 23:11-12
    - Lack of Compassion & Cruelty in Ammon: Amos 1:13
    - Dishonesty & Corruption in Babylon: Jeremiah 51:7
    - Idolatry in the N. Kingdom: Exodus 20:3-5
    - Unfaithfulness & False Worship in the N. Kingdom: Hosea 13:1
    - Injustice & Oppression in the S. Kingdom: Is. 1:17
    - Failure to Repent in ANY NATION: Jer. 18:7-10
    - "...your will be done ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN..."
  - C. **Jesus IS the fulfillment of the Law!** He never sins, represents the promise of the ceremonies, & is the Logos.
    - 2 Corinthians 5:21 Jesus becomes OUR SIN, and we become HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS.
    - Romans 6:11 Consider yourself DEAD to sin...
    - People NEED a NEW HEART in order to live for God.
- 3. So...how are we to vote? → We should vote to PROMOTE GOOD & PREVENT EVIL.
  - A. We vote for a candidate who will promote good & prevent evil (God's values).→Romans 13
    - The President will appoint a cabinet and staff to help them run their Presidency.
    - The President will appoint Supreme Court & Federal judges who will interpret and enforce Laws.

  - secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity


### • The Platform Issues:


