ProQuest eBook subscription changes

- ProQuest recently announced the following
 - August 2025 – no more print book ordering via OASIS or RIALTO
 - October 31, 2025 deadlines – no more eBook purchases, DDA or EBA purchases
 - December 1, 2025 – OASIS sunsets
- Listening session March 6 to review issues and survey to determine impact



ProQuest eBook subscription changes

- Address ways to lessen impact for our schools
 - Should we try to pursue an eBook subscription deal with ProQuest?
 - Convene Task Force to review /suggest alternative methods for eBook purchases?
- Planning EBSCO session on March 20 to review possible options
- Reaching out to other OGS vendors
- Not all schools affected by the change

Functional Update Highlights



Cataloging & Metadata

Metadata policies update: The SUNY Metadata Standards and Policies Working Group (SMSP) has been reviewing and updating the [SUNY metadata policies](#), which have been in place since 2019. The review is now complete and the SMSP will soon be sharing their recommendations with the SUNY community. If you'd like to learn more about the changes and/or provide any feedback, please attend the next [Metadata Interest Group meeting](#) on Wednesday, March 12 when the recommendations will be discussed.

Authority control task list management: Authority control jobs are now running in the SUNY Alma environments, which prompts the need to review headings that come up in the [authority control task list](#). The SMSP has adopted a group management approach, with staff members at multiple campuses as well as SUNY Library Services agreeing to help monitor and manage headings on this list that are connected to Network Zone records.



Discovery

- **Primo VE AI Research Assistant:** The new AI Research Assistant continues to evolve. See our FAQ for [information about how to set it up](#), and for links to Ex Libris documentation.
- **New Discovery Experience (NDE):** The [new discovery platform](#) will go live for testing November 2025, which is a change from the previous target of May 2025. Consortial features like "Get It from another library" won't be configured until later in 2025. There is no rush to migrate, and you'll be able to run Primo VE and the NDE side by side if you want to test it. SLS will migrate all supported libraries at the same time, tentatively during the summer of 2026.



Discovery

- **Mixpanel:** the [new Primo analytics module](#) is currently being beta tested by a group of libraries, including University at Buffalo and Binghamton. Focus is on the "user journey."
- **COUNTER 5.1/SUSHI Presentation:** SLS staff will review the new COUNTER 5.1 platform and how to activate the affiliated SUSHI when vendors migrate to the new platform.
