






# Steps to Register/Renew Your High School Team

Log onto Members Only via <a href="www.usfsaonline.org">www.usfsaonline.org</a> then go to Menu (top left) > Teams > My Teams/Add Team.

\*IMPORTANT NOTE: If you are taking over a team that already exists, but you do not have access to the team profile, DO NOT CREATE A NEW TEAM. Please contact Chloe Roberts (<a href="mailto:croberts@usfigureskating.org">croberts@usfigureskating.org</a>) to be added to the team profile, and then go through the steps to renew.

If you are registering as a **NEW team**, continue reading below. If you are **renewing an ALREADY EXISTING team**, go to page 6.












## **REGISTERING A NEW TEAM:**

Note: All these steps must be competed within ONE attempt. If you try to leave and come back, you will need to go through the whole process again.

1. Select "High School Team" and then "Next".




2. Fill in all relevant fields, verify that the information is correct, and select "Add New Team".












3. You will be taken to your cart which will include your yearly team dues. Confirm that the dues are \$50 and press "checkout" and input payment information. There is an additional \$3 payment processing fee that will be included once you reach the payment page.



Once your payment is submitted, log out and log back in to refresh your profile. Upon logging back in, you will notice "My Teams" will be unlocked. Click "My Teams" to access your new team profile.












4. Select "Main Roster: Manage" to begin editing your team profile. First step is to add team managers and team coaches. Select "Edit Team Profile" to do this.

Note that team managers should be <u>18 years or older and are required to complete</u>

<u>SafeSport™ Training and a background check.</u> Anyone listed as a coach will be required to complete coach compliance as required by U.S. Figure Skating.

Select "Add" under the Team Managers and/or Coaches windows, and input anyone who will be a








manager and/or coach. Note that team coaches are not required.


Once you are finished selecting people, verify the information is correct and select save.



5. Proceed to 2024-2025 Main Roster. This is where you will begin building your team roster.



6. Select "Add Team Member" and click the "Search" button. It is preferable to search based on member number rather than first/last name. Once a skater is selected, they will be added to the roster. **Continue to page 8.** 










### **RENEWING A TEAM:**

- 1. Once you have selected "My Teams" from the main menu, you will be taken to a page that lists all teams that you manage. From there, select "Manage: Main Roster".
- 2. You will be immediately prompted with the below screen to renew your team. To do this, you must update your team information as needed, add/remove any team managers or team coaches, verify the information, and press "Save".













3. Upon saving, you will be brought to your Main Roster. Update your Main Roster by adding new skaters and removing skaters who are no longer on the team. Once your edits to the roster are complete, press "Finalize Team Renewal".



4. Proceed to pay for your renewal. Continue to page 8.









#### **ALL TEAMS:**

Once you have built your roster, take a look at the "Skater Requirements" column. Skater
Requirements are the waivers and forms that each skater is required to fill out in order to
compete or participate on the team. These should ALL say "Complete". If listed as "Not
Complete", you can click to see what components the skater is missing. When all skaters
on your roster have completed their skater requirements, the "Team Requirements" will
be completed.



Skaters can access their forms by going to Account > Member Profile > 2024-2025 Competition Season Profile. Skaters need to complete all waivers and medical registry in order for their Skater Requirements to be "complete" (Medical Registry only requires an emergency contact to read as "complete").


2. If a Minor Athlete (17 years old and under) is on your team, you are required to list them on your roster and <u>ALL SKATERS over 18 years old (Adult Participants) are required to complete and have current SafeSport™ training.</u> If a Minor Athlete will turn 18 in the middle of the season, all Adult Participants on the team are required to complete their Mandatory Athlete compliance requirements. You should be able to track their compliance and training in the "Compliant" column (see below).



The Compliant column will display a future end if the Participants compliance will expire midseason- this date signifies when the Participants SafeSport™ Training will expire. If someone's SafeSport™ Training expires mid-season, they are required to complete the next applicable course in their sequence in order to be compliant for the remainder of the season. The SafeSport courses that meet the Center's mandatory training requirements are, in sequence, SafeSport Trained, Refresher 1, Refresher 2, and Refresher 3.

3. All Team Managers are required to have current U.S. Figure Skating membership, complete an annual SafeSport™ training course, and have a current NCSI green-light background check. All Team Coaches are required to complete all mandatory Coach compliance items, as determined by U.S. Figure Skating. You can track your Team Managers' and team Coaches' compliance in the Team Compliance tab.

You can access the Team Compliance tab by navigating back to the "My Teams" page.










Team managers and coaches should all have a background check labeled "Green Light" and a "Compliant" date in the future.



If a Participant is listed as "No" under the Compliant column, you can click the "No" icon to see what items they are missing.
