December was Glide Rev's highest financial output to the community thus far! This in part, is due to partnering with UCAN which provides an additional source of funding that is being distributed rapidly to those who are rebuilding from the Archie Fire.

As we look ahead to 2023 we hope to keep this stride and get funding into the hands of those still rebuilding their lives. Case work will continue through June of 2023, at which point any remaining fire needs will be handled as "Community Member" requests and funded with any remaining unrestricted funds.

Glide Revitalization is in a unique position. We operate as a non-profit that can obtain grant funding for a wide variety of programs and community based assistance. We also house Douglas County's Long-Term Recovery Group (LTRG). This is a committee of individuals that are governed by a Board of Directors and are fiscally sponsored by a 501(c)(3) organization. All funding that is allocated to this local group of individuals is provided specifically to wildfire impacted community members.

We also partner with many other non-profit organizations to maximize efforts. Often, cases are presented to many community business partners to ensure the client receives the most amount of assistance available to them.
