ALL DIGITAL ACADEMY (ADA)

We're leading this project to establish our academy on digital emerging technologies to enhance digital skills with thematic Community of Practices, MOOCs, Capacity Building activities and other educational activities and collection of resources for educators and trainers. Within ADA we'll be focused on Artificial Intelligence and Internet of Things.



DigCompHub

We're leading this 30 months project focused on fostering the understanding and adoption of the DigComp framework enhancing the existing Community of Practice, and developing a training and mentoring offer with Capacity Building activities and other educational activities for educators and trainers. It is hosted in the ALL DIGITAL Academy platform.

Pedagogical digital competences as a key element for the digital transformation (D-PAIDEIA)

Coordinated by Action Synergy SA, Greece, we are partner of this Forward Looking project aimed at improving the digital skills and competencies of teachers across sectors. D-PAIDEIA aims at updating the DigCompEdu framework providing support to the development of educator-specific digital competences, at all levels, focusing also on the aspects that emerged from the pandemic.



European Digital Skills Certificate – Feasibility Study Tender (EDSC)

Coordinated by NTT Data, it aims at supporting the Action 9 of the Digital Education Action Plan 2021-2027 by exploring different scenarios for the certificate. The study will sustain the selection and analysis of the option that best responds to the needs of the EU, while ultimately generating valuable insights and recommendations for the implementation of the EDSC.

Methodology of phyco-pedagogical, Big Data and commercial videogames producers for the European skills agenda implementation (MEGASKILLS)

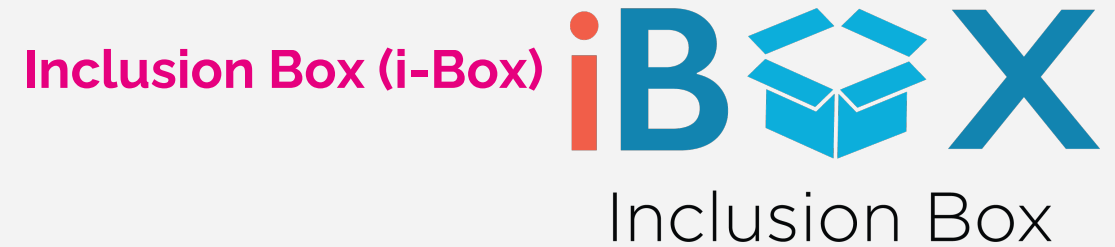
