


SUPPORT REPORT February 2023

The time to rebuild is now

Fire impacted families, this one is for you! A program called Wildfire Recovery and Resilience Account (WRRA) is in effect until June 30, 2023. This program is brought to you in partnership with UCAN. The program funds shelter, clothing, and essential services for those impacted by the wildfire, including reconstruction and replacement of destroyed primary residences. Unlike most state/federal funding, this program does not disqualify any household based on income! Funding awards are based on an income sliding scale, meaning you still may qualify at higher income levels. Proof of loss from the Archie Creek Fire is required. Applications can be found at the Glide Revitalization office. Please call to set an appointment with one of our caseworkers who can help you through this process!

Glide Revitalization is in a unique position. We operate as a non-profit that can obtain grant funding for a wide variety of programs and community based assistance. We also house Douglas County's Long-Term Recovery Group (LTRG). This is a committee of individuals that are governed by a Board of Directors and are fiscally sponsored by a 501(c)(3) organization. All funding that is allocated to this local group of individuals is provided specifically to wildfire impacted community members.
