

SUNY DEISJ Fellows appointed June 2023

Fellows will help shape the new SUNY DEISJ general education knowledge and skills area

Goals

- Build Community of Practice for mentoring faculty teaching DEISJ general education courses
- Develop libraries of DEISJ-related resources
- OLIS recommends Fellows work with their local libraries on collection development



NOVELny: What is it?

New York State Library provides access to NOVELny, an online virtual library connecting New Yorkers to 21st century information via libraries and library systems statewide.

NOVELny is an electronic resource access project that enables libraries across New York State to give their communities online access to the full text of thousands of journals, newspapers and other references.

New Yorkers accessing the databases through a library website or the NOVELny portal while in New York will be able to enter the databases via geoIP authentication (also referred to as geolocation) without entering a username/password or library card number



NOVELny non-renewal

- May 2023 meeting with Lauren Moore (State Librarian) and Amy Heebner (Librarian development)
- NY State library has \$8 million budget, \$2.6 of which has been going to support NOVELny funding.
- NY State library has been using IMLS grant funds to pay for the initiative <u>https://imls-spr.imls.gov/Public/Details/85236</u>
- Due to rising costs of databases and flat federal funding, NY State library will suffer budget deficit of \$1 million by 2024.
- The cultural education fee that supports the NY State library was not included in the enacted state budget, therefore the NY State library can no longer fund this initiative after June 30 2024.
- No plans to extend funding due to challenges inherent in procuring database resources on behalf of NY state, a process that can take up to 18 months and is limited to vendors on state contract.
- NOVELny will not renew June 30, 2024

NOVELny OLIS response

- Analysis of SUNY-wide usage of Gale resources over past three years
 - Gale Academic OneFile (40% of usage), Opposing Viewpoints in Context, Gale OneFile: News most used
- Meetings with Gale and Britannica to review pricing, usage and options
- Convened task force reviewing usage and pricing models
- Meeting with State Librarian about possibility of costsharing across DOE entities (June 2023)
 - Based on SUNY institutional usage
- Meetings with NYALS constituents, led by Sheryl Knabb to continue discussions about impact

NOVELny Task Force

Charge:

This group will make a recommendation regarding potential next steps for OLIS related to the upcoming expiration of the State Library NOVELny database package. Specific tasks and outcomes include:

- Review usage data
- Review overlap and content analyses
- Review offers and procurement vehicles
- Solicit feedback from SUNY libraries

NOVELny Task Force Timeline

Timeline

- June: Call for task force
- August: Initial meeting
 - Met August 28 to review charge
- September: Assign tasks, review usage, pricing models and offers, discuss impact, gather feedback
 - Sept 14: reviewed Gale usage, discussed pricing models
 - Sept 29: review models, mechanisms for gathering feedback on impact
- October: Gather feedback, continue data and usage review, draft recommendations
- November: Final report, recommendations of task group, OLIS webinar on outcomes

Alma / Primo Updates

Alma/Primo Updates

Alma/Primo contract / background

- Initial contract term November 2017 to November 2022. No percentage increase for initial term. SUNY admin covered implementation fees.
- Contract included option for two additional, five-year terms. Negotiated a yearly 2% increase. Currently in the first year of second term. (11/22-11/27).
- Recharge costs for Alma/Primo VE will include 2% increase each year for the next five years.
- Initial PIA for Alma/Primo VE expires June 2024. Will work with business office to re-engage in new PIAs.

RESOURCE SHARING

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Courier Updates

- New Empire Library Delivery contract went into effect on July 1, 2023
- Many SUNY libraries chose to reduce ELD service under this new contract
- SLS worked with SUNY Shared Courier Task Force to adjust our Alma rotas accordingly
 - To date, the average turnaround time for Alma borrowing requests has not increased
- SLS will meet with task force on September 27 to discuss whether rota adjustments need to be made
 - Will meet again in early 2024 and then disband task force if it is no longer needed



Resource Sharing Updates

- Added 6 new in-state partners to our Alma
 resource sharing rotas over the summer
 - Adelphi University, Marist College, Russell Sage College, Siena College, Vassar College, West Point
- Adding 4 Orbis Cascade libraries to our rotas
 - Oregon Health & Science University, Portland State University, University of Oregon, Washington State University
- Beginning to work with CUNY on Alma RS
 - Hope to add all CUNY libraries to our rotas in January 2024
 - Campuses will have an option to opt out
 - Non-ELD libraries will not be able to participate
- Met with Claudia Balby and Katie Burch from Ex Libris to talk more about building network

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ILL eBook Pilot

- EBook ILL pilot project will continue for a second year
- Three new publishers being added to the pilot in October
 - Cambridge Scholars Press (catalog through 2021), Boydell & Brewer (catalog through 2017), University of North Carolina (full catalog)
- SLS will be meeting with ProQuest to discuss long term business model for ebook ILL sometime soon
- SLS will also be meeting with Ex Libris sometime soon to discuss integrating ebook ILL into Alma







 - Audit of communities to assess content and normalize collection names
 - Contacting campus IR managers about possible migrations of content to SOAR
 - Linking out to other SUNY digital repositories



Repositories

- SUNY Open Access Repository (SOAR)
 - New batch load process allows campus IR managers to create SAF (simple archive format) files for upload
 - Empire State University's <u>All About Mentoring</u>, a faculty-led scholarly and creative biannual publication, now in SOAR
 - Purchase College has begun uploading <u>Student</u>
 <u>Projects</u> to SOAR, creatively utilizing the embargo feature and metadata to suit their campus needs


