 - Everyone please share your response as comfortable and wrap-up your discussion!
 - Use the information below in your discussion.

Affinity bias or ingroup bias, this tendency or preference for people like ourselves, is well-researched and common. In general, people extend greater trust, positive regard, cooperation, and empathy toward people who are similar. It may also manifest as an aversive tendency toward dissimilar individuals. While this is often not intentional, unconscious preferences for people like ourselves can cause us to favor those similar to us in professional and personal situations. Goal: Complete an Initial Analysis and Begin Idea Generation

We recommend your team use this time to do an initial SWOC (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, challenges) analysis and begin idea generation related to incorporating or enhancing EDI in the curriculum or assessment activities. As time allows, begin prioritizing your ideas.

Home Team Time #3 (January 19, 2023: 4:40 p.m.-5:30 p.m. EST):

Goal: Complete Idea Generation, Idea Prioritization, and the Instructional Design Template

We recommend your team use this time to continue idea generation and prioritization, culminating in an instructional design plan or plans related to incorporating or enhancing EDI in your curriculum or assessment activities. The goal is to produce one or more ideas that your home team would like to get feedback on during the Troika Consulting activity on Friday morning, Jan. 20th (tomorrow). Consider if your team would like to develop one idea and have all individuals present the same idea in different random Troika Consulting groups or if you would prefer to have different individuals on your team present different ideas to gain feedback on more than one idea. If you are a larger team (4+), we encourage you to consider presenting more than one idea across your team. Assign which team members will present which ideas tomorrow.
