WORSHIP MINISTER

Purpose

To plan and lead CHBC's worship services, for God's glory.

Description

The Worship Minister leads the crafting of CHBC's Sunday morning services, so the congregation is transformed into the likeness of Christ through singing, prayer, and partaking of the Lord's Table. They lead the congregation in worshiping through music, incorporating hymns and modern worship songs. They lead the Worship Planning Team in the weekly design of Christ-centered worship services, as well as the long-range planning of services. They recruit, develop, and shepherd a team of lay-leaders, musicians, and volunteers who play a significant role in leading the music ministry at CHBC. The Worship Minister partners with the Lead Pastor to ensure that song choices and flow of worship support the ministry of the Word. They also partner with the Executive Pastor to ensure that Sunday services are aligned with CHBC's vision of being transformed by the gospel, and our mission to equip our church to make Jesus known in the Triangle and beyond.

Reporting Relationships

The Worship Minister reports to the Executive Pastor.

Lead the music ministry of CHBC

- Lead the Worship Planning Team in crafting services that glorify God, yet also exhibit undistracting excellence in execution of details
- Select hymns and contemporary songs that are theologically rich and awaken affections for God
- Cultivate a contemporary style of music
- Make use of the vast musical gifting within the CHBC congregation
- Lead worship service rehearsals

Plan the worship services for Sunday Mornings

- Design a Christ-centered arc for the worship services
- Ensure our services display CHBC's Vision, Mission, and Values
- · Lead and implement the vision of the Lead Pastor for our worship services

- Attend to the personal spiritual growth of worship team members
- Be available to coach and develop worship leaders for other ministries (e.g., youth)

Be a team player on our Ministry Team

- Lead the staff in growing in their understanding of and appreciation for corporate worship
- Be available to add value and wisdom in other ministry departments
- · Play an active role in ministry staff meetings
- · Engage relationally with our Ministry and Support Teams

Pursue personal growth

- Seek personal growth in relationship with God, as well as growth in character and conviction
- Continue to develop musical gifts
- · Grow in ministry competency, best practices, and current trends
- · Grow in biblical and theological competency and depth

Minister to the church body at large

- Care for and shepherd members and attendees
- · Provide discipleship and counsel as needed
- · Play a role in weddings and funerals as needed

Perform other duties as assigned by the Executive Pastor
