












# Recommended Camping Equipment for Scout Troop 19


## Clothing:
















- Extra pants 
- Extra shorts 
- Extra shirts 
- 1-3 extra wool/poly socks 
- Sock liners
- Wool hat, gloves 
- Hiking boots or good walking shoes 
- Swimsuit, swim goggles 
- Underwear (long if cold)
- Brimmed hat for sun 
- River shoes (Keens, Teva, etc) 

## Sleeping:

- Sleeping bag and stuff sack 
- Pillow

- Biodegradable soap 

- Small swim towel

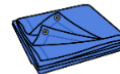

- Personal First Aid kit

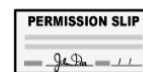


- Whistle
