City of Reno McKinley Arts & Culture Center East and West Gallery

The former McKinley Park School was constructed in 1909 and renovated in 1999. The mission style architecture was one of four such schools built in Reno at the time. The stucco-surfaced school is U-shaped with a central open court and an arcade sheltering the main entry. A two-story central tower stands at the base of the U, with a one-story wing extending behind. Now known as the McKinley Arts & Culture Center, it occupies an important place within the Truckee River Arts and Culture District in the City of Reno.





Submission requirements

Entrants must provide no more than (5) images via JPEG or PDF format. Image resolution must be min. 200 dpi. of 2D and/or 3D works to be considered forthe exhibit. Not all works will be selected.

- 2D Drawings and Plans must be no larger than 30" x 42"
- 3D Models and Mixed-media must provide dimensions of work
- 3D Models and Mixed-media Interpretations: A few pedestals will be made available.

printing details below

Provide an 8.5" x 11":

- Cover letter with a 2nd sheet containing the following information:
 - Name of firm and/or individual and a brief description of firm or of the work, to be displayed with the work (ex. how long in operation, type(s) of projects, etc.)
 - Nevada L.A. license number of firm representative or LAIT number
 - Name of L.A. Student and/or Landscape Architect.
 - Contact information (phone and email both)
 - Project name
 - Project date
 - Project location approximate (ie. City)
 - 2D or 3D work dimensions (printed or ready to display)

Artwork guidelines

Students please contact Amanda Rookey at northsection@nvasla.com to organize the printing of your work for exhibit. NVASLA will cover the cost of printing for students.

PRINTING

- Send the files, for approved artwork, to Rick's AEC Reprographics in Reno. Entrant will cover the cost of printing and mounting. Send files to Rick's no later than Wednesday, March 5, 2025. Let them know that the work is for the NVASLA Exhibit.
- Rick's has a sliding scale for color prints, they will also mount work on foamcore. You will need to specify weight of paper, low paper sheen or gloss, and black or white foamcore.
- Reach out to them directly for pricing at: 775-324-7425 or printing@ricksaecrepro.com
- NVASLA will pick up all prints and prepare them for hanging.
- 2D design work must be either mounted on foam core, printed on board, or framed in a basic black frame. A few small tabletop easels will be made available. NVASLA will provide the hanging hardware and wire.
