Alma Resource Sharing

- Alma Resource Sharing has been turned off for all SUNY institutions as of March 18, 2020
- No date for turning resource sharing back on has been set at this time
- SLSS staff have turned off borrowing and lending at all SUNY libraries
- Please reject lending requests in the Being Processed status, and scan in items that are in the Shipped Physically status but haven't actually been shipped yet (this will complete the request on both ends)
- Turn off Export to Third Party function if you don't want unfilled requests being exported to ILLiad
- I will be creating an FAQ on cleaning up request lists soon







Resource Sharing and Fulfillment Configuration Changes

- Temporary SLC Policy (until July 31, 2020):
 - https://slcny.libguides.com/ld.php?content id=52873224
 - All RS borrowing and lending loan periods now 16 weeks with 3 renewals
 - Automatic Renewals allowed for RS requests
 - Open SUNY users (i.e. Walk-in borrowers) can now submit resource sharing requests
- SLSS staff have taken care of configuration changes needed to implement these new policies (and will undo changes once policy expires)
- Some additional work will be needed to give Open SUNY users RS requesting privileges in Primo










Resource Sharing and Fulfillment Configuration Changes - Borrowing Loan Periods
















Resource Sharing and Fulfillment Configuration Changes - Open SUNY RS Requesting





Returns Procedures

- Users can now return any book borrowed from or through a SUNY library to any SUNY library
 - Applies to regular Alma loans, Alma resource sharing, and ILLiad/OCLC resource sharing
- Regular Alma loans and Alma resource sharing items should be sent back to the owning library
 - Scanning item back in will complete resource sharing requests on both ends
- ILLiad/OCLC items should be returned to the borrower's home library
- Tracking form for returns

Turning Lending Off in ILLiad/OCLC

- If you want to turn off all lending in ILLiad, you can change your OCLC Supplier status in the Policies Directory from Yes to No
- If you want to turn off just returnables lending, you can set up a Deflection Policy for Loan requests in the Policies Directory
- Policy Directory can be accessed through ILLiad's System tab

Updating Due Dates in ILLiad

- No way to batch update borrowing or lending due dates in ILLiad client or Customization Manager
- IDS Logic can batch adjust loan periods
 - Add a set number of days to the current due date
 - Create a new due date based on current date
- IDS Logic only updates due dates in ILLiad (OCLC due date will not change)
- Email <u>logic@idsproject.libanswers.com</u> if you want your due dates adjusted
 - Be sure to include process type, queue name(s), and exactly how the due date should be adjusted









Primo Header

If you want to add a new link to your Primo header:

- Go to Discovery->Display Configuration->Configure Views
- Click the three dots to the right of your view to get Edit option
- Click on the Links Menu Tab
- Add link, use anything for Code
- Use up/down arrows to reorder

- Go to Discovery->Display Configuration->Configure Views
- Click on the Manage Customization
 Package tab
- Follow instructions in this

- Edit custom1.css file under css folder, put code at end of file
- Edit wording in content: "" to read whatever you want it to say






Primo Homepage - Body

Things to note:

- Two column layout with first column at 60% of page and second column at 40%
- Could add div above first div that would span whole page
- md-card coding is what makes the layout work responsively and look the way it does









Adding Chat

Notes:

- JavaScript can be fiddly may need trial and error to get your script code into the right spot
- If you can't get it to work, try creating a new widget in your chat system
- If you don't have time or interest in making chat interactive, could just put a link in your header or on your homepage


