Accessing the Training

For the **Cub Scout College**, there are two designated Zoom rooms. Each room will have a **single Zoom link** that will remain active throughout the day. You will not need to log in and out between sessions, simply stay in the assigned room for your scheduled courses.

Each Zoom room will have a **dedicated moderator** who will help facilitate the sessions. Moderators will assist with collecting and relaying questions to instructors. If you have a question during a session, please **type it into the chat**, and the moderator will ask it on your behalf. To maintain an orderly learning environment, **all participant microphones will remain muted** throughout the training. This decision is based on valuable feedback from previous years, ensuring clear and uninterrupted instruction for all attendees.

Technical Requirements & Support

To participate fully, please make sure you have access to both **Zoom and Basecamp** before the training begins on **Saturday**. These platforms are essential for joining sessions and accessing course materials.

Important Notes on Technical Support:
