Follow LNT Guidelines - Particularly the first principal "Plan Ahead"

Appalachian Trail Conservancy WEB site

- Click on Explore
- Click on subject of interest
- ✤ Be sure to Register on AT Camp
 - ➢ When camping keep crews to 10 individuals
 - ➤ Leave shelters for solo hikers carry tents or tarps
 - Be aware of others. Move off the trail to a durable surface for breaks and to allow other hikers to pass.
 - > Up hill hikers have the right away
