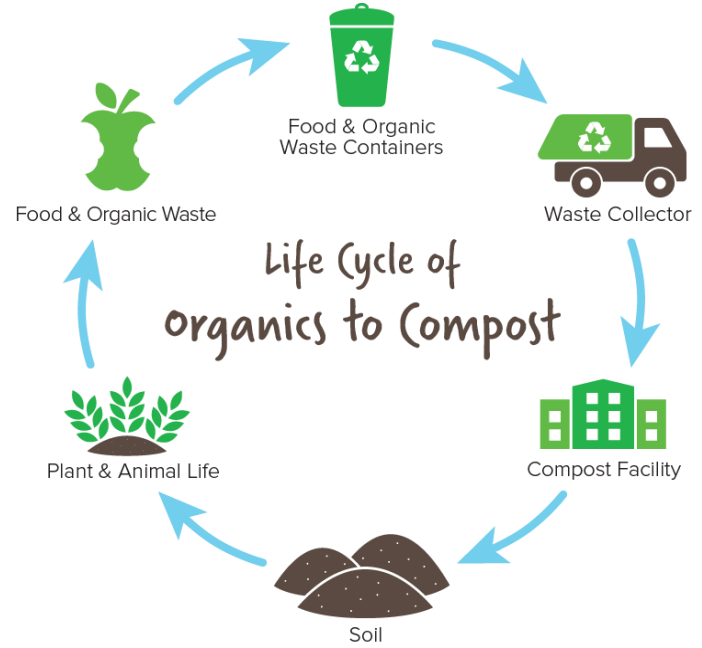


WHO WE ARE - OUR MISSION

ENVIRONMENT

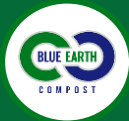
- Soil is climate change solution

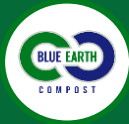

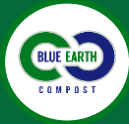
We created our service to help those that want to compost, but don't have the time, space, or expertise.

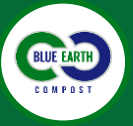

The most accessible solution for getting food scraps out of the waste stream. This is the way many municipalities across the world approach food waste diversion.

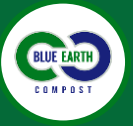
- A 3rd bin is provided to residents and is collected the same day as waste and recycling

- Lower maintenance than windrow composting
- Uses “off the shelf” technology

ON-SITE COMPOSTING - IN VESSEL



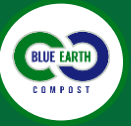
Benefits of in vessel composting:
