Dr. Cassandra Howard, Brig Gen, MD, MBA VP Chief Medical Officer, Methodist Le Bonheur Germantown Hospital

Cassandra Howard, M.D., joined Methodist Le Bonheur Germantown Hospital in 2003 as a full-time, emergency medicine physician. She served as the assistant medical director for several years and in 2014 was appointed as the medical director for the emergency department at Methodist Le Bonheur Germantown Hospital. She was named the hospital's vice-president/chief medical officer in 2017.

Dr. Howard graduated from Howard University in Washington, D.C., with a Bachelor of Science degree in Medical Technology in 1993. She earned her Doctor of Medicine degree from the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee (1998) and completed a combined residency in internal medicine and pediatrics at the University of Tennessee Health Science Center (2002). Dr. Howard is a 2014 graduate of the Methodist Le Bonheur Healthcare Physician Leadership Academy. In 2018, she was awarded a Master of Business Administration degree from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.

Dr. Howard has 34 years of exemplary service in the United States Air Force, Air National Guard component. She holds the rank of Brigadier General (0-7) and is the Assistant for Mobilization and Reserve Affairs, in the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs at the Pentagon, Washington, DC.
