- Shared strategies: NICE K12 Cybersecurity Education Conference and StaySafeOnline.org




#### **Outcome and Challenges**

### **Our vision**


Create relatable content for younger kids (pre-school to elementary), using research based techniques, making it is easy for them to understand complex but important cyber safety concepts.

- Focused on fun





He's fast, fluffy and looks like a cloud.




That's because Digital Dan has a secret helper, it's a silver shield with malware detectors.

# Our Goal: Aligned with our vision


#### Every child –


