



## Mastering Number at Reception & KS1 FAQs

### When will the first set of resources be available?

The first set of resources will be available in Axis in time for the beginning of the autumn term.

At the end of the 2024/25 academic year, teachers are encouraged to download the materials to continue their Mastering Number teaching in class. If schools go on to join the Embedding the Impact Community, they will keep their access to the resources for a further 12 months.

### What should I do if I cannot see the resources on Axis after registering?

- 1. Ensure you have used the same email address when registering on Axis as was provided on the application form for the programme.
- 2. Ensure that you are looking under the 'Resources' tab on Axis
- 3. If the email address is the same and you still cannot see the resources, email <u>Booleanmathshub@clf.uk</u> with the Heading "Mastering Number at Reception & KS1" with your query, quoting your school, postcode and name.

# What do I do if I haven't received an invitation to join the online Basecamp Community?

#### How many Rekenreks will each school receive, and when will we receive them?

Eligible schools (those who have not previously engaged with Mastering Number at *Reception & KS1*) will receive a set of 60 Rekenreks (there may be some adjustment for smaller schools). Rekenreks will start to be delivered to schools during the week commencing 9 September.

#### What happens if there are two teachers who lead one year group?

Only one Lead Teacher per year group can be registered to the Mastering Number Programme at any time. Lead Teachers with access to Axis are encouraged to download a copy of the resources to share with colleagues.
