


What is Basecamp?

Have you ever worked on a project at your church that relied on email chains, teams from many parts of the church, or tried to manage documents and versions of documents – an then try to find something at a later date? It can be a challenge (and maybe just a bit frustrating and time consuming!)

Enter Basecamp – a tool to help your church organize projects, teams, documents and more.

How can Basecamp help your church be more organized?

Basecamp can enable your Church Council or Consistory to have its own space for all you do. Each of your teams can also have their space for projects, documents (think meeting minutes and project documents) and communications too.

One of the challenges for volunteer organizations is to keep track of what is going on; not only today, but to remember what has happened previously. Basecamp enables all of that!

What is the cost of Basecamp?

Good news -- This tool is FREE to congregations! The conference has purchased this service and pays the monthly fee of about \$90/month.

There is no limit on the number of congregations or project/team sites you can have.
