

1 ACCECSSING THE PSET MIS

The PSET MIS is a Website. A website is a set of related web pages located under a single domain name. PSETMIS is a set of webpages under the domain name:

“openvemis.gov.vu”. A Domain name is a registered space in the internet or the World Wide Web. Contents are organized in web pages according to the needs of the users, people who access the web page to carry out organizational activities.

To Access any webpage, you need a Computer device that has an internet browser software and is connected to the internet.

You also need to know the web page address of the key pages of PSET MIS and know how to use it in an Internet browser to access the pages.

1.3 RELIABLE INTERNET ACCESS

- (1) PSET MIS is free on Digicel mobile broadband.
- (2) PSET MIS is free on Vodafone mobile broadband.
- (3) Wi-Fi Hotspot that has internet connection

1.4 MOBILE PHONE HOTSPOT

- (1) All smart phones nowadays have hotspot capability
- (2) Hotspot feature is usually in the Mobile Hotspot and tethering in the Settings Section of the phone,
- (3) All phone settings have a search tool
- (4) Search for the Hot spot using any of the following key words
 - a. Hotspot
 - b. Mobile Hotspot
 - c. Mobile Hotspot and tethering
 - d. Tethering
- (5) Clicking on the Hotspot result should take you to the Hotspot and Tethering Dash Board, The Dash Board holds the features available for Hotspot and tethering services.
- (6) You need to get to the Dash Board for the Mobile Hotspot feature. To do that, click the name Mobile Hotspot.

1.6 ADDRESS BAR

1.7 ACCESS DETAIL

- (1) The Provider Management must request a username for all its staff using the PSETMIS Access Request Form
- (2) You must logon using a username and password so that the system can identify you and apply security that controls what tasks you can perform.
- (3) There are different groups of user logon in Open VEMIS: (VQA, Provider, Delivery, Assessor, Trainer/Lecturer)
- (4) For this Guide we will look at Provider and Delivery Site Access
- (5) For the first log on, use the default Password: **Aa12345** .

1.8 LOGGING IN INTO PSETMIS WITH THE DEFAULT PASSWORD

- (1) The default password will be assigned to you by the PSETMIS Administrator in two Cases.
- (2) When your account is first created
- (3) When you forgot your password and your password has been reset.
- (4) Every time you use the default password, you will automatically be taken into the changed password page. This page has no title, it has two check boxes and 1 button and 1 page instruction. These are the **New Password** Text Box, the **Confirm New Password** text box and the **Save Password** Button. The page instruction has instruction on what you will do.

1.9 PROCEDURE TO ACCESS PSETMIS DESCRIPTION

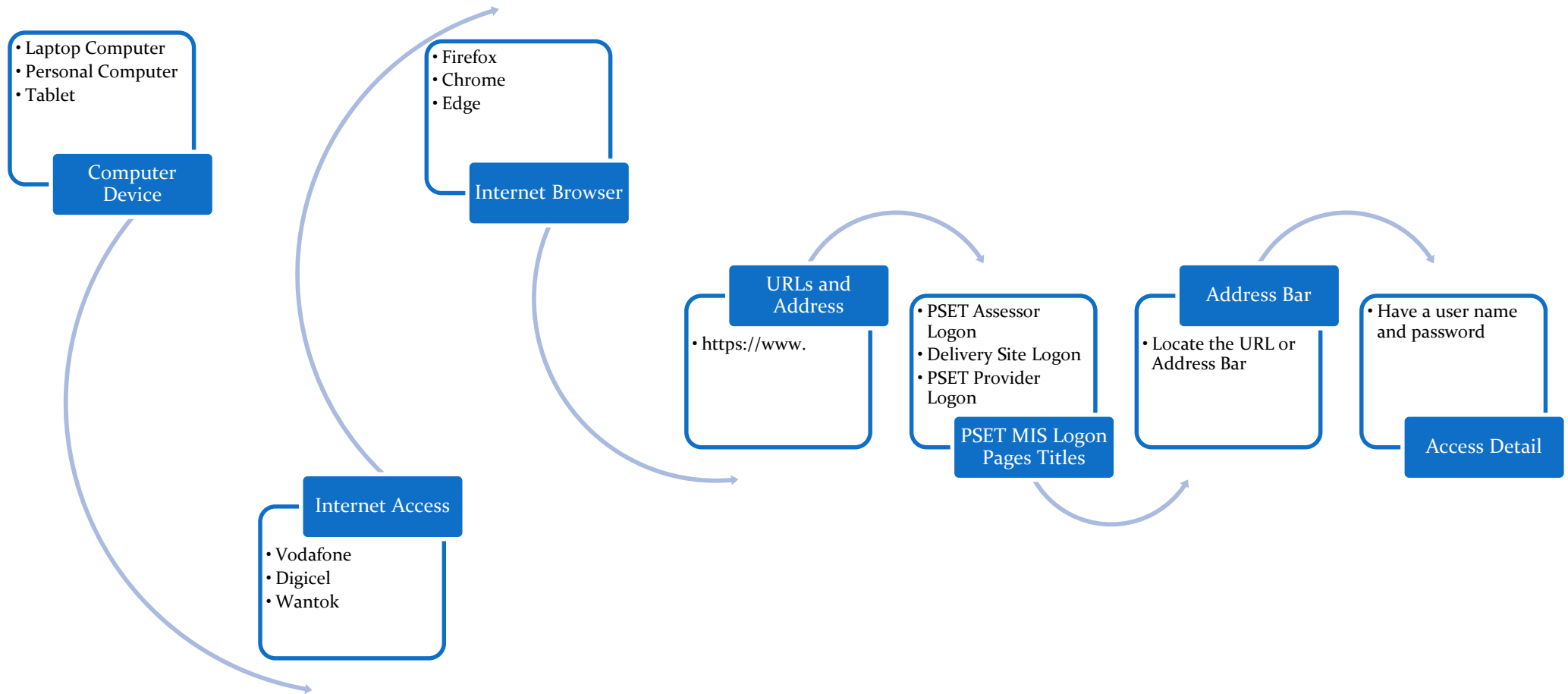
Three ways were identified to access the PSETMIS,

- (1) Firstly is how to access the PSET MIS using the Domain name and Menus. If you memorise the domain name of Open Vemis go to **5.2.1**

- (2) Secondly is how to access the PSETMIS using the PSET Logon Pages URL or webpage addresses. If you memorise the web address or the URLs of the PSET MIS page logon Pages go to **5.2.2**

- (3) And lastly, if you do not memorize the web page address or URL for the Open VEMIS domain name or the address of the PSET logon Pages, is using Search Engines to access the PSETMIS. Search Engines require data. All modern web browsers have search engines embedded in their Address bars. If you enter an entry that is not in the format of a web address in the address bar, the search engine in the address bar will search for the entry entered. Please follow procedure **5.2.3**

1.11 USING THE DOMAIN NAME AND MENUS DESCRIPTION (DNM)

- (1) Access the Open VEMIS domain name. The domain name is openvemis.gov.vu, the domain name is a URL and is the homepage address or the Landing Page address of the Open VEMIS.
- (2) In the Home Page, Click the PSET Menu to Access the Home Page or the Landing Page of PSET MIS

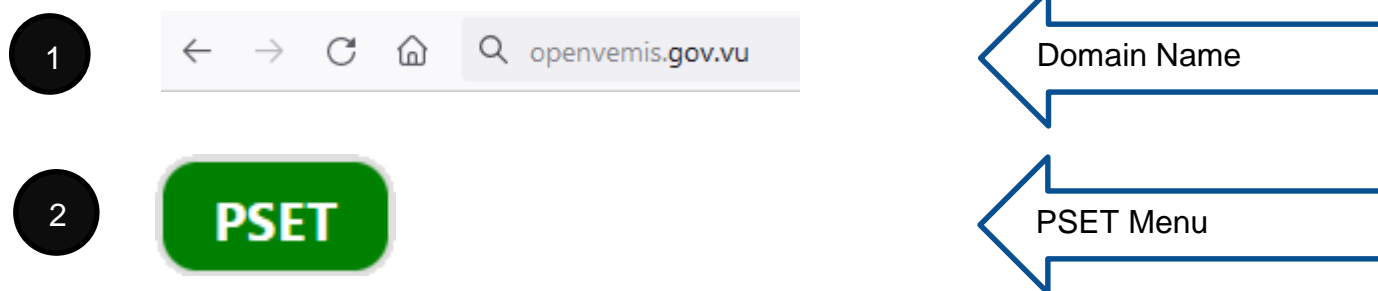
If you are a Provider Administrator go to 3,

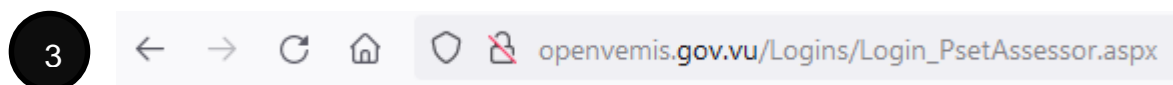
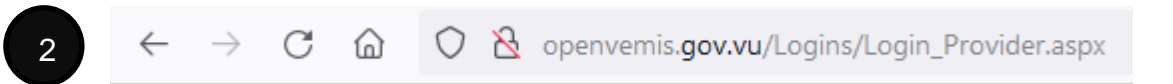
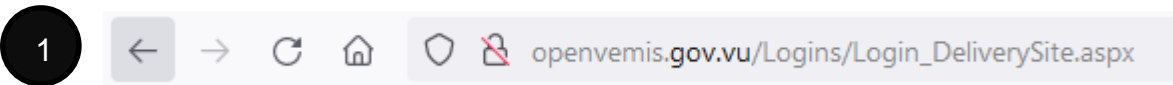


Figure 1 : Logon Section of the PSETMIS Log on Pages

 - (5) To find PSETMIS Log on Pages use
 - a. PSET Assessor Logon
 - b. Delivery Site Logon
 - c. PSET Provider Logon
