### STARTING SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 1

#### 1 & 2 Year Old Classroom

- Maximum Room Capacity:
  - O 8 children
  - o 4 volunteers
- Safety Protocols:
  - O Children are not required to wear masks
  - O Volunteers are required to wear masks
  - O Physical distancing will be encouraged

#### 3 Year Old - Pre-K Classroom

- Maximum Room Capacity:
  - O 8 children
  - O 2 volunteers
- Safety Protocols:
  - O Children are not required to wear masks
  - Volunteers are required to wear masks
  - O Physical distancing will be encouraged

## Elementary (K - 4th Grade) Classroom

# Attending King's Kids

### **Pre-Registration**

We will have parents pre-register their child(ren) for each space due to limited capacity.

On the Monday before a Sunday experience, registration for each King's Kids space will open. In order to guarantee a spot for your child(ren), parents are encouraged to preregister. If spots are still available, you may check-in your child on Sunday at the 9:30 Worship Experience.

#### Check-In

Upon entering the Marigold Event Center, follow the signs to the King's Kids Check-In Station. There will be marked spots on the floor every six feet to maintain physical distancing.

If possible, please only have one parent check-in your child(ren).

In order to check-in, both the parent and the child(ren) will have their temperature checked by a touch-less thermometer at the forehead. If a child or parent has a temperature of 100.0 °F or higher, the child and parent will not be allowed to enter the King's Kids space. (A child should be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication before entering King's Kids).

After the temperature check, you will pick up your family tags at the Check-In Station. Check-In volunteers will be the only ones allowed to touch the iPad used for check-in. There will be in no self check-in station.

Once you have completed check-in, the parent should take their child(ren) to a hand washing station and wash hands before being dropped-off into the designated King's Kids space. Please show your tags to the Security volunteer in order to enter the King's Kids wing.

Hand-sanitizing stations will be located in each room for hand washing during the worship experience.

There will be no outside food or toys allowed into our spaces. Any snack served in the spaces will be prepared by leader wearing gloves and each child will get their own prepackaged / cup of snack.

## Pick-Up:

Parents will be asked to maintain social distancing while entering the King's Kids space to pick up their child(ren). The floor will be will be marked spots on the floor every six feet. Please show your tag to the Security volunteer to re-enter the King's Kids space.

The volunteer team will make sure each child sanitizes their hands before departure from the space.

# **Expectations of King's Kids Volunteers**

Volunteers will be temperature checked before entering the King's Kids spaces. Any volunteer with a temperature of 100.0 °F or higher will not be allowed to serve. (A volunteer will not be able to serve if they have not been fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication.)

Volunteers will be required to wear a mask at all times.

Volunteers will be required to do a thorough hand washing before entering the space as well as hand-sanitizing throughout the experience.

Volunteers will sanitize all toys after each service.
