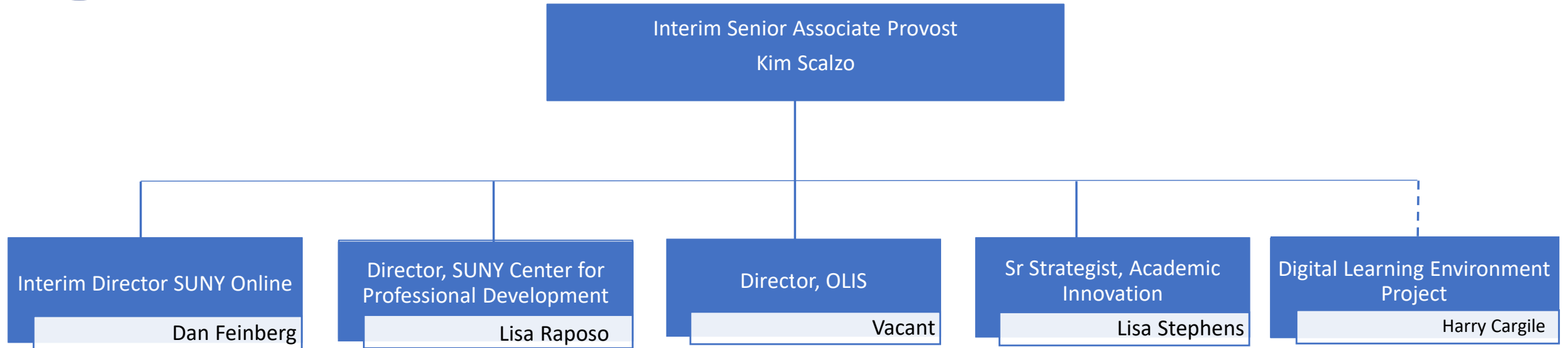

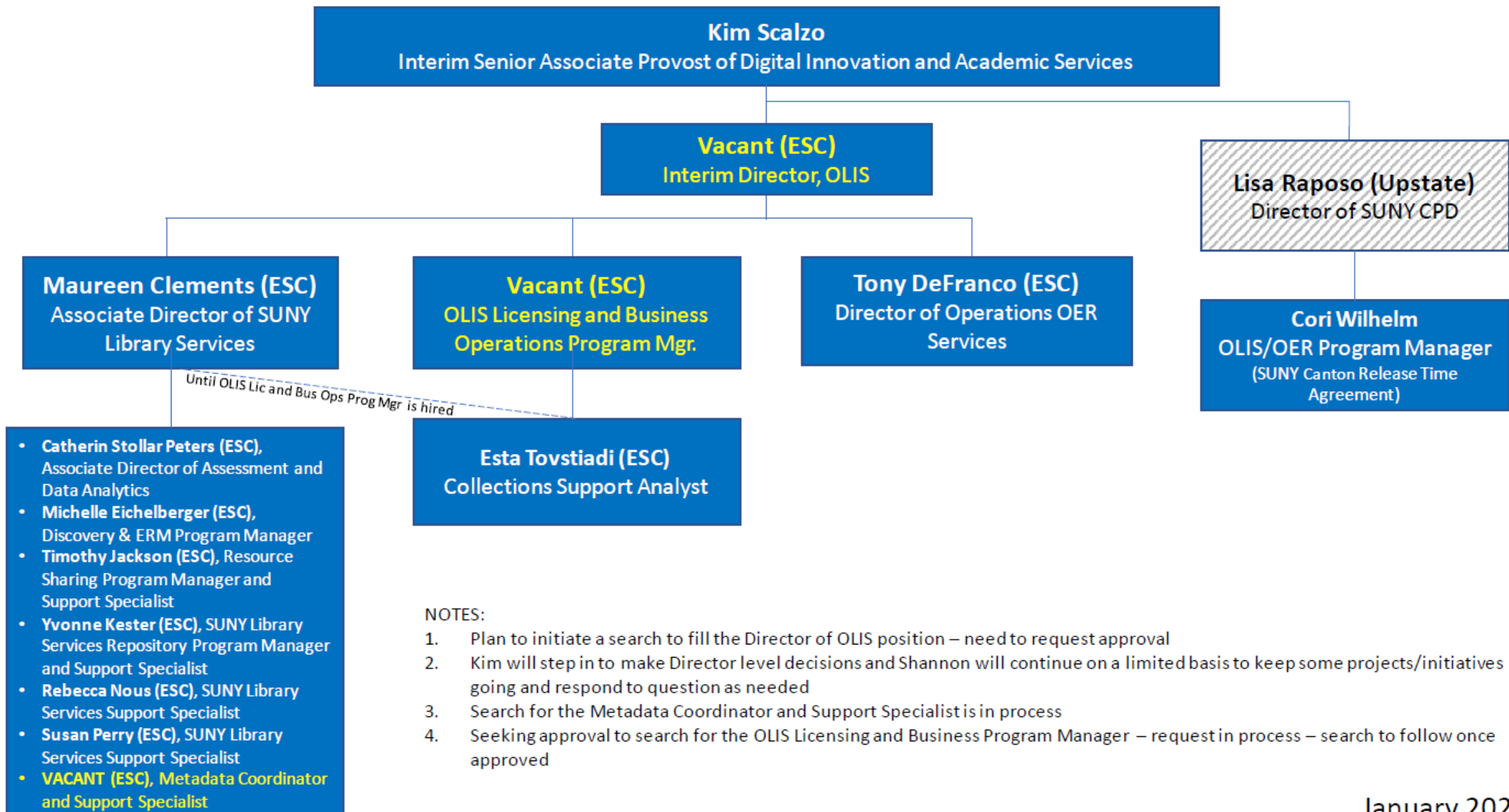

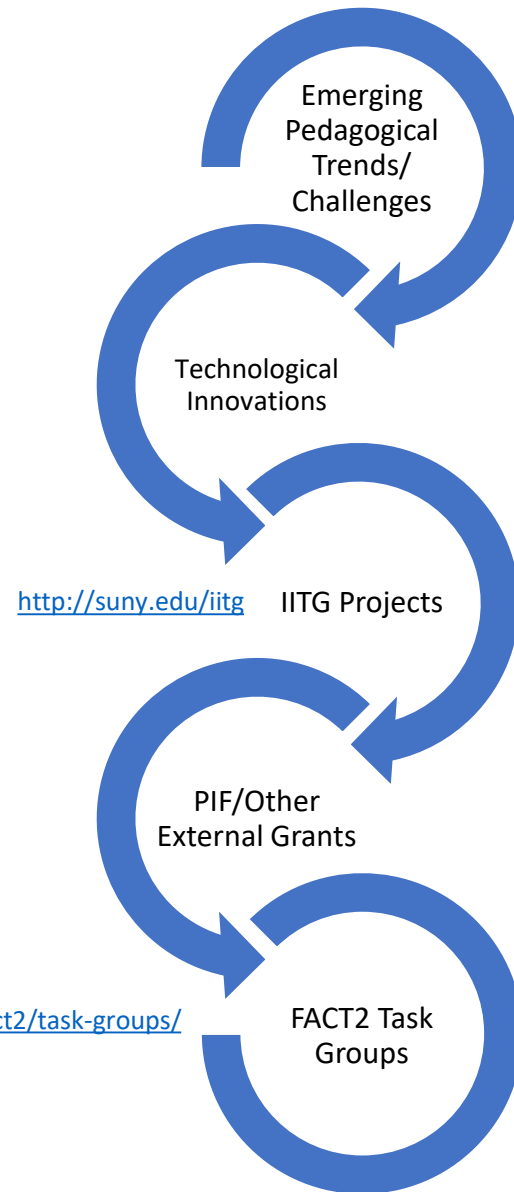

SUNY's Innovative Instruction Ecosystem

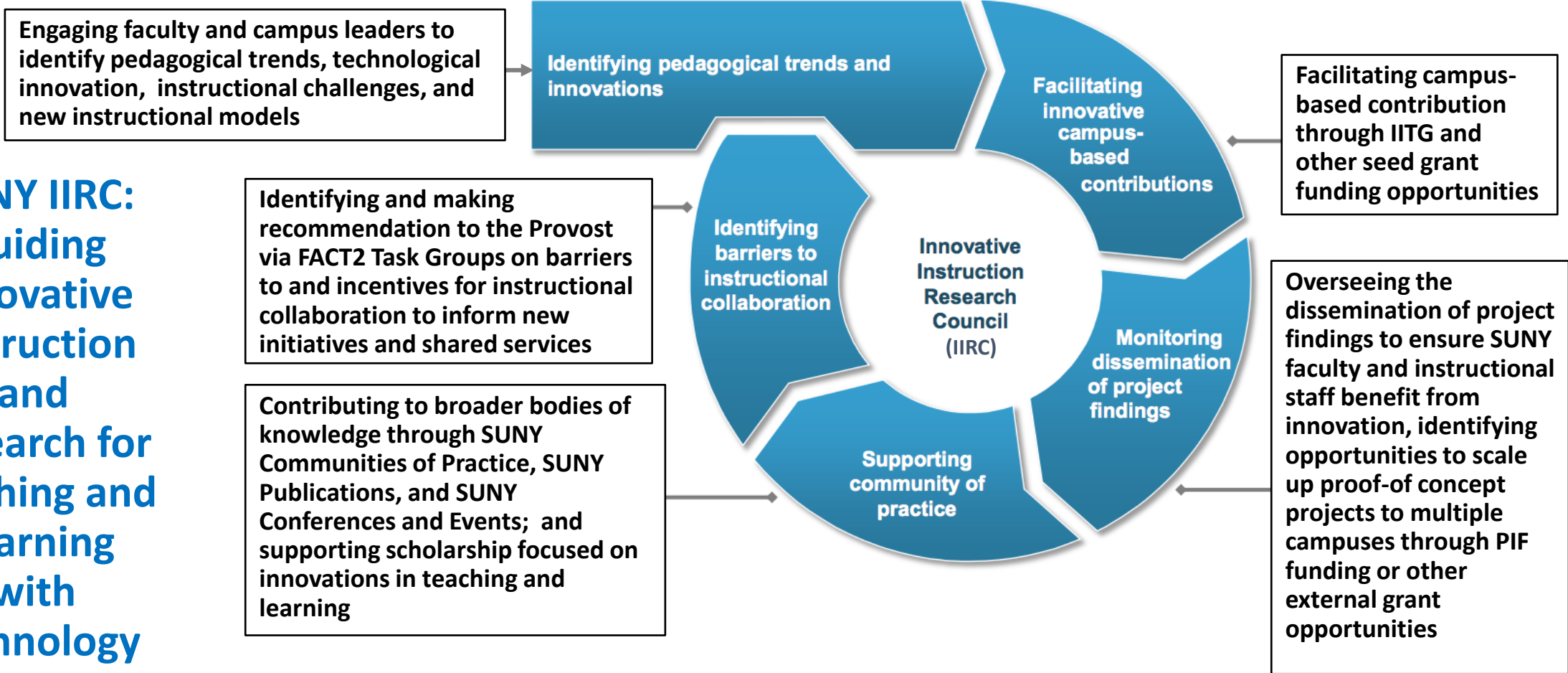

General Updates

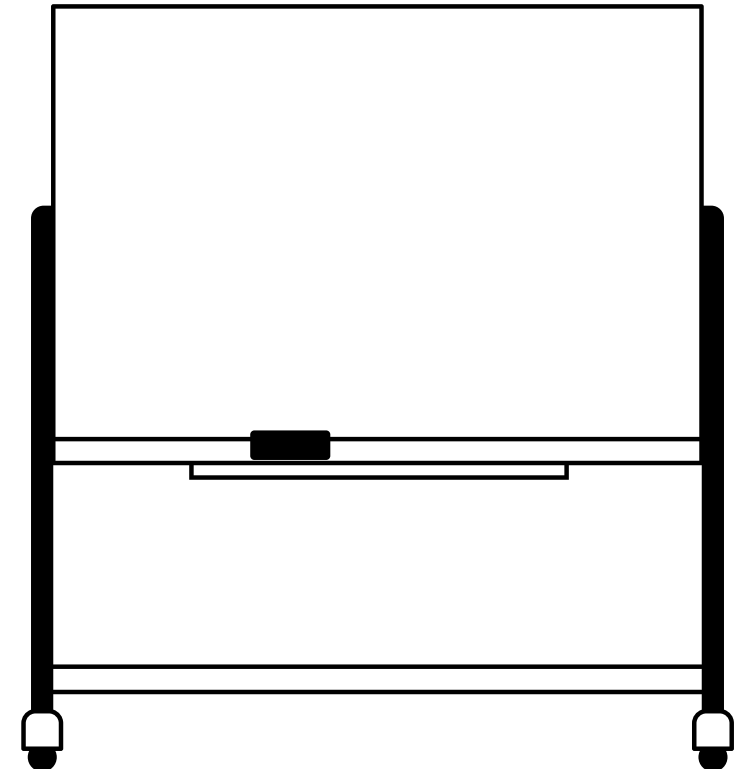


- SLC to OLIS Springshare transition
 - May be updating the base URL for the site.
 - Possible change to ticket email address
 - We'll continue to communicate any changes and provide redirects to avoid broken links
 - Fall 2023
- Final stages of Metadata Coordinator and Support Specialist position.
- Sync Extended Support PIA agreements to Fiscal Year
 - Term for existing PIAs remain in place
 - Slowly roll over to July 1 timeframe



Onboarding

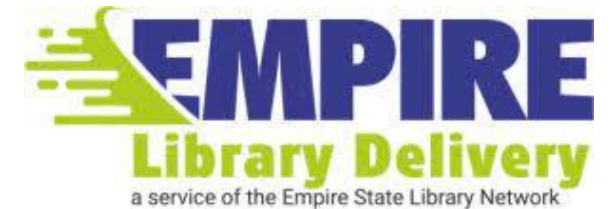
- Helping acclimate librarians and staff to their to new roles:

SUNY Shared Courier Update

- ESLN working through the RFP process for new ELD contract (the current contract expires at the end of June)
 - Expecting 30%-40% price increase
 - ESLN currently working with vendors on reducing pricing
 - Final pricing information should be available in March or April
- SUNY libraries have always been required to have 5-day ELD service, but libraries will be able to reduce service once the new ELD contract goes into effect
 - The SUNY Shared Courier Task Force recommends retaining at least 3-day ELD service
- Libraries will be billed directly by ELSN under the new contract (past billing was done via recharge)





Expanding Alma Resource Sharing Beyond SUNY

- Working with the ConnectNY consortium to add several of their Alma libraries to our Alma resource sharing network
 - Go-live with Vassar College and the U.S. Military Academy at West Point this spring
 - We're hoping to go live with additional libraries later this year.
- New Alma resource sharing partnerships with the Connecticut State Colleges and Universities (CSCU), Gettysburg College, Susquehanna University, and the University of Central Florida
- Goal to expand participation in these partnerships and our partnerships with the California State University system and the Washington Research Library Consortium (WRLC)





Ex Libris / ELUNA



- Monthly meetings with Ex Libris rep, Claudia Balby
- Quarterly meetings with Ex Libris Support team
 - Working on backlog of support cases
- February quarterly release went smoothly
- In-person ELUNA User Group meeting in May 2023
- ELUNA steering committee president to attend next IEC meeting to discuss NERS voting



Open Athens / EBSCO

- Open Athens is an identity and access management service that can replace EZproxy.
- Special discount from EBSCO:
 - If five schools sign up, they each receive a 20% discount
 - SLS offering small one-time implementation incentive
 - Central billing

OCCLC Small Cataloging & WorldCat Visibility

OCCLC – Small Library Edition for small library staff to effectively manage metadata for the Institution's collection

- Only for libraries with an FTE up to 3000
- Shannon Pritting will reach out to qualifying libraries

WorldCat Visibility Subscription:

- Option is available to libraries that maintain any OCLC cataloging subscription
- Less expensive than FirstSearch
- Includes the features of OCLC web visibility program (WorldCat.org, Google, Yahoo)
- Shannon Pritting will reach out

Amendment to current OCLC contract currently in the works.

General Collections Updates

- Anticipated Lapse in OGS State Contract Coverage for Books (award 22868) and Serials (award 23044)
 - Expires February 28, 2023
 - OGS expects the contracts to be finalized in March, contingent upon Office of the State Comptroller.
 - Recommend purchase orders be cut before February 28th to hold until the new contracts are approved.
 - EBSCO still honoring – you may have received notice from EBSCO
- Artstor Contract still in process
 - If you experience any access issues please submit a ticket



JSTOR Task Group

Task Group determined **Opt-in** contract best way forward

- JSTOR Subscription Model changing moving forward
 - For 2024 renewal, community colleges will be moved to an expanded-access model
 - Comps and Doctorals can opt for Expanded Access or stay with current collections for 2024 renewal
- All-in contract didn't provide beneficial pricing for all campuses



SLS Collections /eBook Task Group

Goals – to secure buy-in for shared eBook collecting across SUNY.

- *Revised timeline to FY24/25*
- Develop a *cost model* / plan for the first two years of eBook collecting program
- Research acquisition models, products, consortia management models
- Review vendor proposals and commit to Year 1 procurement
- Recommend next steps for ongoing management of consortia eBooks (committee, working group etc.)
- Continued communication through basecamp, sector meetings and presentations
- Gather data from new GenEd framework to inform potential collection strategy

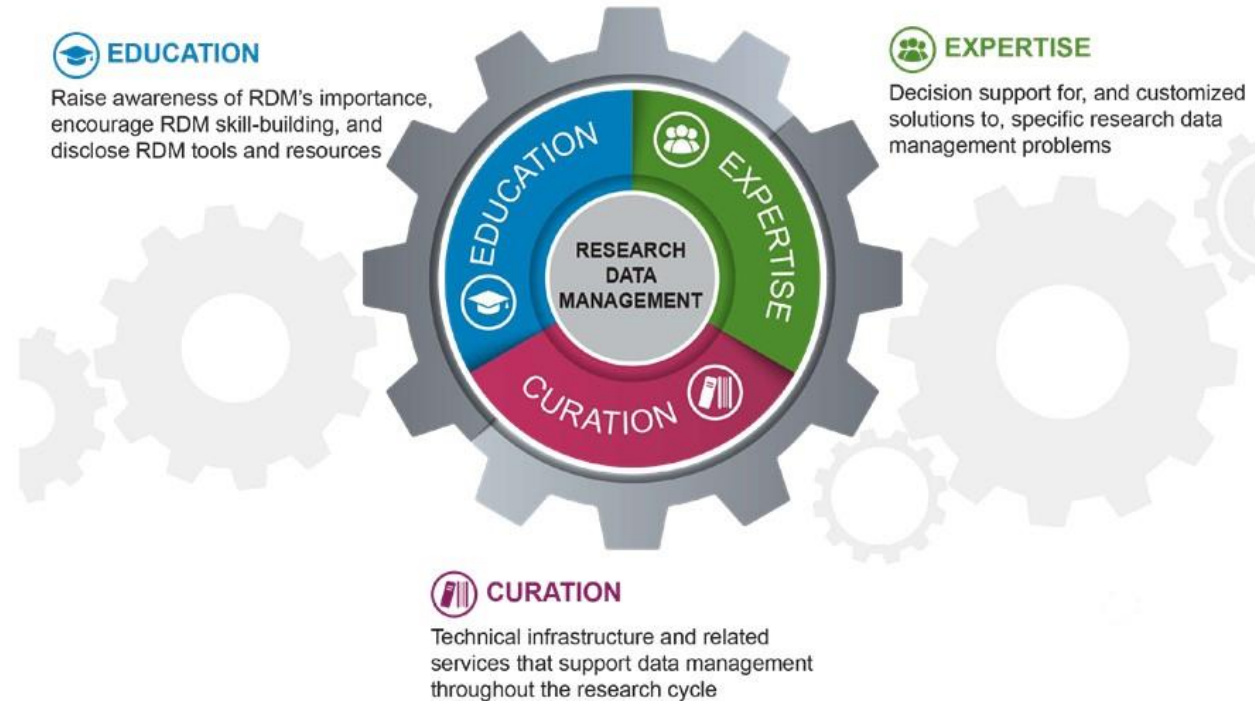
