

## Sermon on the Mount part 5

Matthew 6.19-7.6

To be a disciple of Jesus is to be a citizen of a different kingdom.

Principle: Don't live like citizens of the \_\_\_\_\_ if you are citizens of the \_\_\_\_\_.

Don't store up treasures on earth but instead store up treasures in heaven.

- Because God is the ultimate \_\_\_\_\_.
- Because treasures on earth are vulnerable but treasure in heaven is \_\_\_\_\_.
- Because what you treasure will determine the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of your life.
  - A "bad eye" is a deep darkness.
  - You \_\_\_\_\_ what you love.

Don't worry about your standard of living or necessities but instead prioritize and pursue the kingdom and righteousness.

- Because \_\_\_\_\_ is more important than stuff, even necessary stuff.
- Because God is the ultimate \_\_\_\_\_.
- Because you can't \_\_\_\_\_ it anyways.
- Because \_\_\_\_\_ has enough challenges and who knows whether the future stuff you're fretting about will happen.

Don't be judgmental but instead make sure you're seeing clearly.

- Because you'll be judged by the same \_\_\_\_\_ you use on other people.
- Because God is the ultimate \_\_\_\_\_.
- Because you probably aren't seeing other people \_\_\_\_\_.
- Because other people won't \_\_\_\_\_ your correction if you're a hypocrite.
