 - a. Easily identify resources by label from brief results
 - b. Displays in Resource types Facets
- 3. Cons of local resource types
 - a. Impacts all libraries linked to the NZ record
 - i. NZ LRT impact any holding library that is linked to the affected records
 - b. Needs to be configured in NZ and IZ
 - i. NZ configuration impacts all NZ linked records
 - ii. Needs to be configured in the IZ in case there are IZ only records that the LRT should be applied to
 - c. Limited to 20 local resource types SUNY-wide
 - i. If a policy is created to use them, the LRT would need to be decided on by SUNY
 - d. Impacts facets
 - i. Local resource types will display under the LRT facet and not be included in books (or ay Alma out of the box resource type)
 - e. Impacts advanced search if filter by Material type
 - i. Need to create a Material type for Local Resource types if not using "All items"
 - f. Requires additional training
