USING "SHARE WITH NETWORK" IN THE MD EDITOR




"Share with Network" in the MD Editor

- The "Share with Network" functionality shares Institutional Zone (IZ) bib records with the Network Zone (NZ) in the MD Editor
 - The IZ bib record and associated inventory will be linked to the NZ record
- It allows Alma users with the cataloger role the ability to directly link IZ records to the NZ without running a job
- "Share with Network" can be used to:
 - Add/link an IZ brief bib record to the NZ
 - Add/link an IZ bib record to the NZ that were created either:
 - From migration
 - In error

Repository Search to Identify Unlinked IZ Bib Records

An advanced repository search can be performed in the IZ to see a list of physical titles that are not linked to the NZ. Below is a very basic search that will also display Reserves, Main-Borrowing and Main-Lending Resource Sharing titles will display in the results



Pre-requisites to using "Share with Network"

- 1. The IZ Non_Serial_match_profile and Serial_match_profile configuration for Resources "Other Settings" needs to match the NZ configuration for theses settings
- 2. IZ bib records <u>must have an OCLC #</u> in MARC field 035 because SUNY's NZ bibliographic environmental matches on the OCLC #
 - a. The OCLC # is the match point for bib records in the NZ:
 - i. NZ bib records are maintained and updated via the OCLC nightly jobs using the OCLC# as the match point
 - ii. Exporting OCLC master records manually to the NZ match on the OCLC #
- 3. When adding the OCLC # to an IZ bib record the 035 should be entered as follows:
 - a. 035 _ _ \$\$a (OCoLC)#########

Configuring Non_Serial and Serial Match Profiles

To configure Resources "Other Settings" one of the following roles is required:

- Catalog Administrator
- Repository Administrator
- General System Administrator
- 1. Go to Configuration>Resources>General>Other Settings
- 2. Edit and/or verify the following settings:
 - a. Non_Serial_match_profile: com.exlibris.repository.mms.match.OCLCMatchProfile
 - b. Serial_match_profile: com.exlibris.repository.mms.match.OCLCSerialMatchProfile




3. Click Save

"SHARE WITH NETWORK: WORKFLOW




1. Click *Edit Record* (or *Edit* from the record view) to open the IZ only bib record in the MD Editor




- 2. Check for an existing 035 with the OCLC #
 - a. Add the OCLC # to the bib record if one is not present:
 - a. Click *Edit>Add Field* (F8)
 - b. Type in 035 _ _ \$\$a (OCoLC)########
 - c. Click the **Save** icon (Ctrl+S)
 - b. 035s with other system numbers can remain in the bib record because the match point is in the OCLC #



- 3. Click File>Share with Network
 - a) The IZ bib record will be added to the NZ if there are no matching bib records in the NZ, otherwise move to step 4







- 4. Click **Yes** when the "Confirmation required" pop-up message appears with the following: "Matched record/s exist in the catalog; do you want to view them before saving?"
 - a) DO NOT CLICK No! It will add a duplicate bib record to the NZ




5. Click *View* to verify this is the correct bib record




6. Click **Back to results**



7. Click *Link*




- 6. Click *File>Save and Release Record* (Ctrl+Alt+R)
 - a) It will save and release the NZ bib record from the MD Editor (right-side of the split screen editor)



7. Click **Back** or **Exit**

a) Save and Release the Record for the IZ only bib record does not do anything because the IZ record has been link to the NZ and uses the NZ bib record in the MD Editor



8. The IZ only bib record is now linked to the NZ



REPORTING BIB RECORDS TO BE DELETED FROM THE NZ



Reporting Bib Records to be deleted from the NZ

- Report bib records to be deleted from the NZ when a bib record is accidentally added/exported to the NZ that should be in the IZ
 - Instructor/personal copy course reserves
 - eBooks
 - Equipment
 - Host bib records for bound-withs
 - Suppress bib records
 - Proprietary vendor records
- Makes sure the IZ bib record is unlinked from the NZ before reporting NZ bib records to be deleted
 - FAQ: How do I unlink a bib record from the NZ?
- Report NZ bib records to be deleted
 - Request to delete bib records
