


HISTORIC POPULATION GROWTH - TOWN


HISTORIC AND PROJECTED POPULATION - COUNTY




REGIONAL POPULATION GROWTH (2010 - 2018)






POPULATION PYRAMID






BACHELOR'S DEGREE POPULATION






MEDIAN HOME VALUES






YEAR BUILT








UNEMPLOYMENT RATES












TOTAL NUMBER OF VEHICLE CRASHES, 2013 - 2017




