

Basics of an IRI

- IRI is a **peer review** not an audit
- Focus on: Industry, Nature, Waste or Water
- Host organisation decides on the exact topic(s)
- IRI team consists of:
 - Team leader
 - Rapporteur
 - Between 4 to 6 specialists (depending on the focus areas)






Steps in an IRI

CROSS-CUTTING * IMPEL *

- 1. Pre meeting (host, team leader, rapporteur)
- 2. Set date, focus and expertise needed
- 3. Form a team
- 4. Travel and other arrangements
- 5. IRI week
 - a. Questionnaire
 - b. Indicate good practice and opportunities for development
 - c. Presentation to host (and higher management)
 - d. Draft report
- 6. Final report
