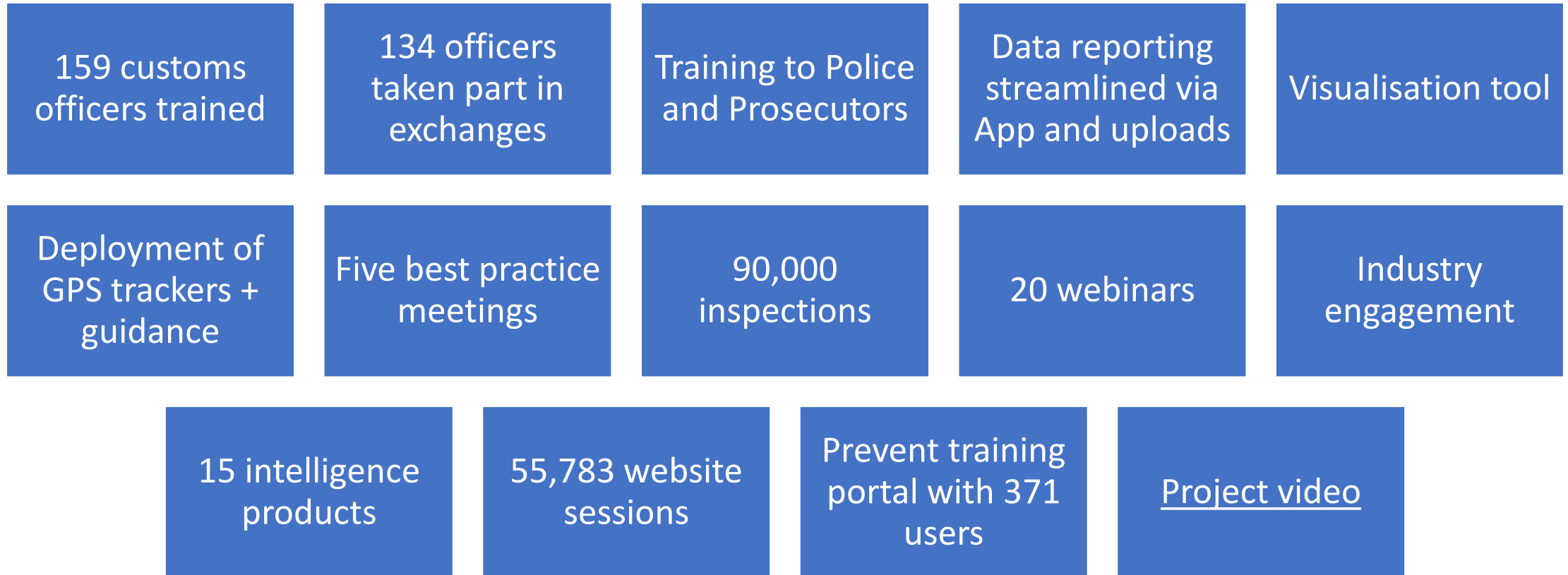

- The tools: Reporting App, training portal, visualisation tools



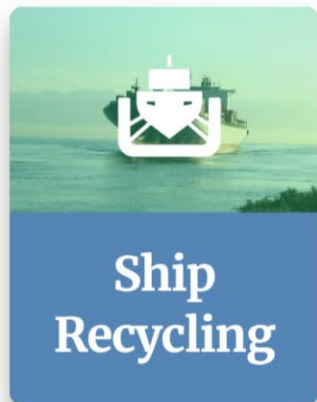

Standardised data recording at shipment level ('gold standard')



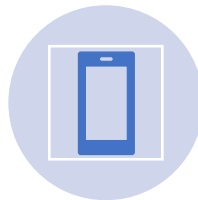

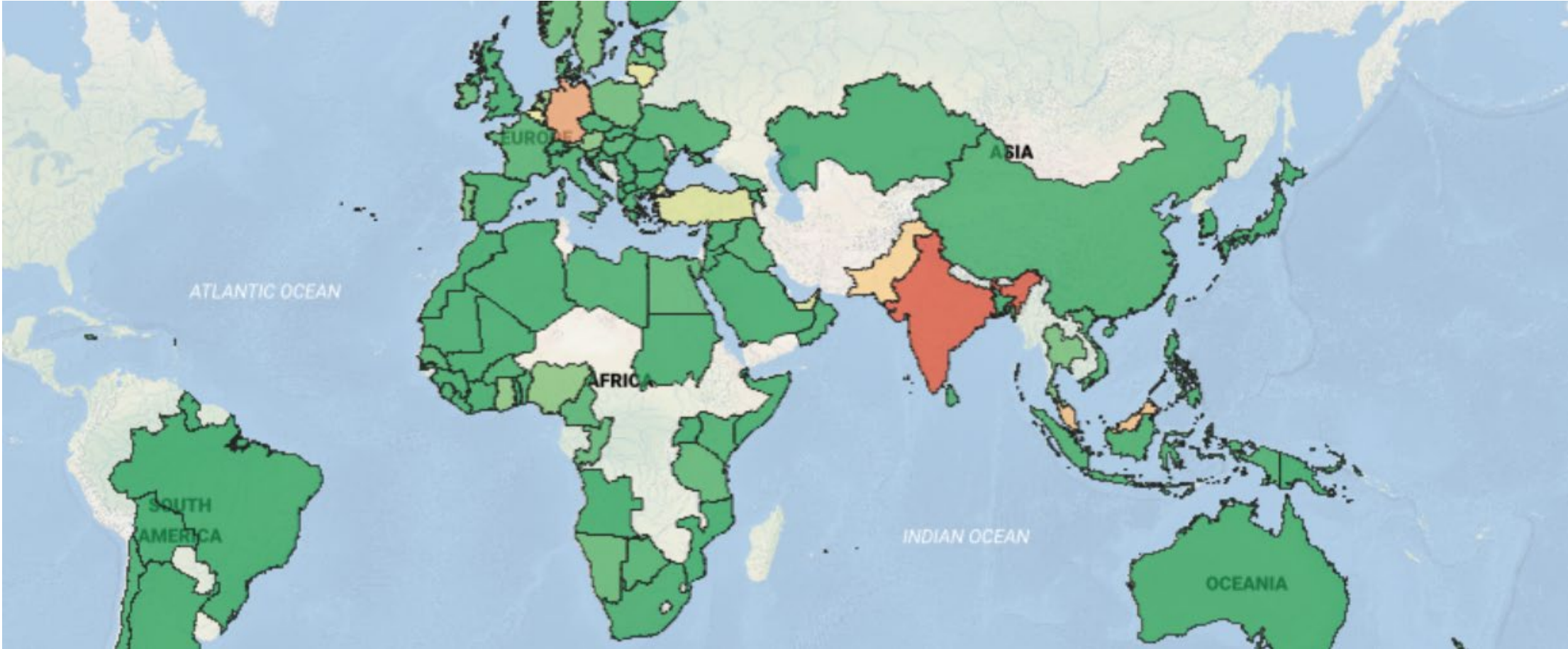
References to legislation, problematic waste streams, waste codes

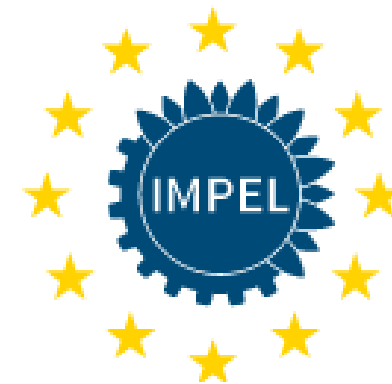
