Fungi: An Overlooked Kingdom in European Conservation

- Fungi are neither plants nor animals.
- Fungi are vital for ecosystems but still **overlooked** in conservation.

JoNeF focuses on:

- **Highlighting** fungi's role in ecosystem health
- **Ensuring** fungi are **recognized** in European biodiversity strategies
- **Building** a strong IMPEL network to advance fungal conservation in Europe





Achievements So Far (2023-24)

July 2023 – JoNeF project launched

We have already achieved important results.

- We conducted a Europe-wide survey on fungal conservation efforts, resulting in the JoNeF Survey Report
- We developed a guidance with concrete recommendations for fungal conservation policies (still on approval)

Over the next three years

- 🔔 2025 Report on fungal information systems in Europe
- 2026 Proposal for mycoindicators to assess habitat quality
- **11 2027** Process for integrating fungal data into European environmental systems

- **Connecting** the scientific community and governments **through IMPEL** for better environmental governance in mycology.
- Some European countries have integrated fungi into environmental policies in different ways. IMPEL can help foster harmonization.
- Strengthening collaboration and promoting applied research on mycological indicators and habitat quality.




JoNeF: Expanding Our Reach
