

Latinx Caucus invited to the UIPR Library Week 2023

On April 27, 2023, via Zoom, Elaine Tornés Blanco and Marisol Florén-Romero presented our caucus to students and faculty at the Inter-American University of Puerto Rico (Arecibo, PR). See the 1-hour presentation at https://tinyurl.com/LibraryWeek2023

Martín F. Rosado Rojas, Director at the René Marqués Library of the Inter American University of Puerto Rico (Arecibo Campus), invited Latinx Caucus to present remotely during the Library Week. The presentation covered a background of the American Association of Law Librarians (AALL), its chapters, caucuses, mentorship program, and awards. The audience had the opportunity to learn about law librarianship, what the law librarians do in different work environments like academia, government, and law firms. Elaine Tornés provided a history of the Latinx Caucus since its beginnings in 2005 and shared its mission and purpose, explaining the job opportunities and compensation in law librarianship. Marisol Florén was interviewed about her experience in law librarianship and the value of being part of the Latinx Caucus.
