Enterprise SYSTEMS & SUPPORT

Platforms for healthcare systems clinics, and other enterprise settings

- Clinical administration and management

Clinician SERVICES & SUPPORT

Platforms primarily for clinicians and clinical support staff

- Health Information Technology
- Electronic medical record and prescribing
- Point of care and workflow enhancement tools
- Telehealth platforms



Patient-facing **WELLNESS &** SUPPORT

Products that capture, store, or transmit health data

- Lifestyle and wellness
 - Activity and fitness trackers
 - Medication reminder
 - Wearables and sensors (non-clinical grade)
 - Consumer health information



Patient-facing DIAGNOSTIC & MONITORING

Products used to diagnose, guide diagnoses, or actively monitor patients

- Digital diagnostics
- Digital biomarkers Remote patient
- monitoring tools Wearables and biometric sensors
- (clinical grade) Medication ingestible
- sensors Connected drug delivery devices

Patient-facing THERAPEUTIC INTERVENTIONS

Products that deliver medical interventions and therapies

- Digital therapeutics
- » Clinical interventions delivered directly to patients via software to treat, manage, or prevent a disease or disorder
- Non-DTx medical devices (e.g., insulin pump, artificial pancreas, pacemaker, CPAP)

Telehealth/Telemedicine

Additional channel for care delivery

New category of medicine



Education For All Plus Accommodating Students with Additional Interest

- All students core digital health areas built into the curriculum
- Students with additional interest
 - Elective track
 - Above plus electives and preference for digital health experiential experiences
 - Possible focus in a particular area of digital health (e.g. informatics, programming, business)
 - Adjunctive degree (concurrently or prior/after)
- Further post-graduate training (e.g. residency, fellowship)




Figure 12. Overview of concepts related to digital health covered in pharmacy school



Tie it in: Therapeutics

- Reinforce specific DH tools in their respective disease states
 - Continuous glucose monitoring in diabetes
 - Smart watch EKG in arrythmias
 - Sensor enabled inhalers in asthma or COPD
 - Bio-ingestable medication sensors





Figure 13. Overview of infrastructures provided to support digital health education



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Didactic (digital health-focused)

- Health Informatics^a / Digital Health^b
 - Importance of established (e.g., digital inhalers, wearables) AND
 emerging (e.g., artificial intelligence, blockchain, chatbots) technologies
 - Hands-on assignments (e.g., app design contest, Cryptozombies blockchain, Cognitive.ai certificates, FreeRice social good, Google Cardboard virtual reality, Grasshopper coding, Misfit wearables)
 - **_ Career planning** and industry indicators (e.g., resources for seeking digital health positions, review of opportunities)
