POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Health Center Director will evaluate and treat campers and staff for minor injuries and illnesses, supervise and ensure implementation of medication policies and procedures at camp, keep a log of Health Center visits, give supportive advice to counselors and other camp staff if requested, and consult with the Camp Nurse to identify health problems serious enough to require a physician's attention.

This position will have the following responsibilities:

- · Caring for the medical needs of campers and staff at camp
- Conduct initial health screening of all campers and staff and collect all medications.
- Provide medical attention to campers and staff with general health concerns and document in Health Log.
- Distribute and record camper medications.
- Maintain Health Center record and medical forms.
- Supervise the Health Care assistants.
- · Communicate specific camper health needs (allergies, special diets) to staff.
- Communicate with Camp Directors about camper health issues.
- Schedule appointments for sick/injured campers or staff to the hospital or clinic.
- · Comple pre and post camp health center inventory list
- Stock First Aid supplies in the Health Center and all areas of camp and controlling their outflow.
- Safeguarding the camper's prescription medications; administering and logging the medications at the prescribed dosages and hours
- · Ensure the health center cleanliness and sanitation is maintained daily
- Maintain the isolation area ensuring procedures are followed and space is kept clean and sanitary
- Participate in camp activities and events as time allows.
- Attend all meals.
- Assist with enforcing and implementing camp safety standards and emergency procedures.
- Complete other tasks related to the implementation of a quality youth summer camp program, as requested.
